About

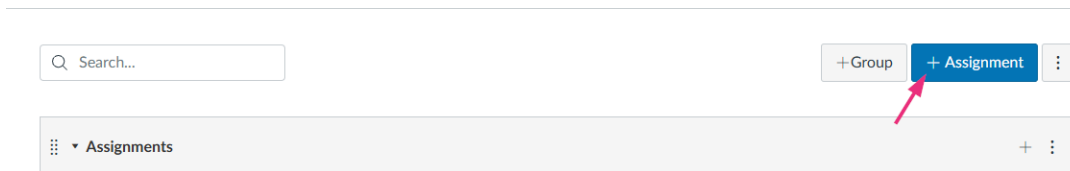
Instructors can create assignments in Canvas that allow students to submit video recordings using Kaltura’s Embed Media tool.

When a student submits a video, it is cloned under a new username (**OriginalUserName_assignment**) and will no longer appear in **My Media**, ensuring that the submission cannot be edited or deleted after submission.

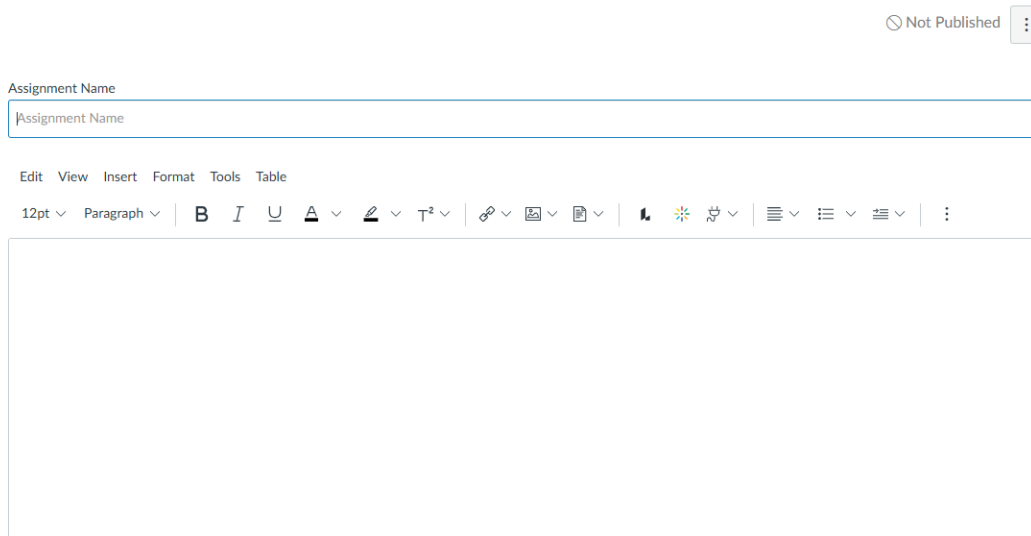

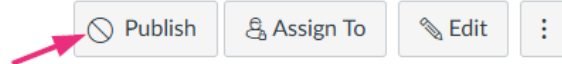
1. In your course, click **+Assignment** in the top-right corner.

For this assignment, you will create a 2-3 minute video analyzing an aspect of the Prehistoric Era. Choose one of the topics below and explain its significance using historical evidence and examples.

- Choose one of the following topics:
 - Hunter-Gatherer Societies – How did early humans survive, and what were their daily lives like?
- The Role of Fire – How did the discovery of fire change human civilization?
- Cave Art & Early Communication – What do prehistoric cave paintings tell us about early human culture?
- The Agricultural Revolution – How did the shift from hunting and gathering to farming impact society?

Your video should include:

A brief explanation of your chosen topic.

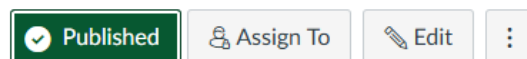
Key historical details and evidence.

Submitting a text entry box

The button will turn green and display **Published**, confirming that the assignment is now visible to students.

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If students experience submission issues, ensure the **Text Entry** submission type is enabled in the assignment settings.



If your institution uses Kaltura's LTI 1.3 integration, confirm that student permissions allow them to upload and submit videos.
