Make your storyboard global!

1. After you have set up a local storyboard in your room, click the **three dots menu**.



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If there aren't any items already on the storyboard, the menu will look like this:

2. Click Save storyboard.

3. Enter a name for the global storyboard (max 40 characters).

Manage a global storyboard

After creating a global storyboard, you can rename it, import to another storyboard, or delete it.

- 1. On the storyboard, click the **three dots menu**.
- 2. Click Manage storyboards.
