#### About

Enabling and configuring the **Link to original video** plugin allows a user who is playing a clip entry to easily navigate - with a click of a button - to the original entry from which the clip was derived.

#### Setup

To learn how to configure your player with **Link to original video**, see Player - Settings tab.

#### Features

The functionality of the plugin differs according to the type of player you are using:

#### VOD player



- A reference to the original entry displays in the top left corner of the player.
- A **Watch full video** button to navigate to the original entry is available just below the reference. Depending on how your account is configured, when the button is clicked, the original entry either opens in new tab (default) or loads in the player.
- If your account is configured with the **Link to original video** plugin, the reference to the original entry replaces it.
