

## Set up a video quiz - Theming

### About

You can create interactive quizzes based on existing media in Kaltura. Video quizzes help engage viewers and measure understanding while watching content.

You can create a quiz from the Video Portal, your LMS video integration, or directly from the Rich Media Content Management System (Rich Media CMS).



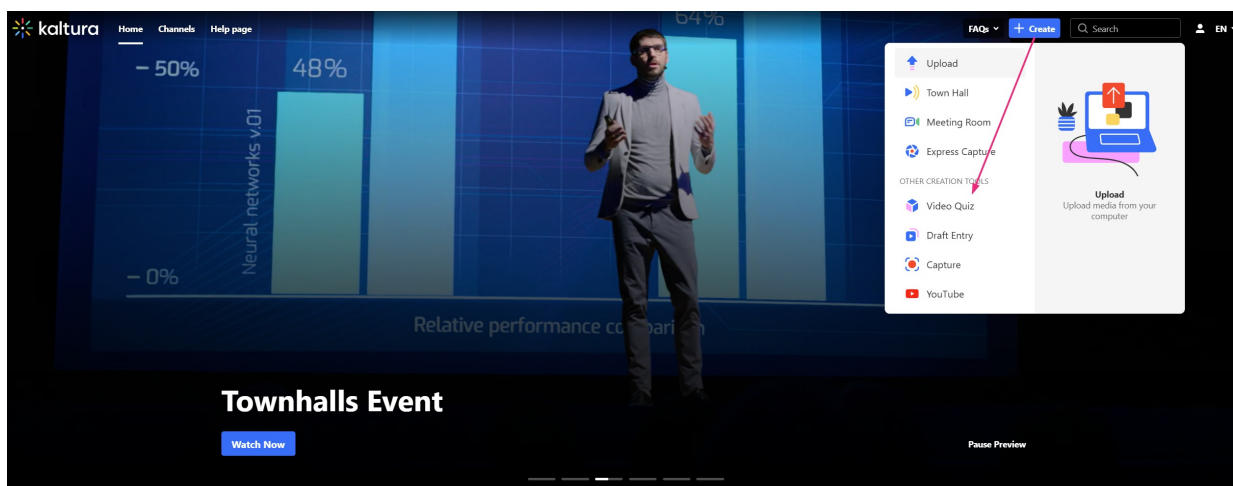
- Make sure the [Editor module](#) and [Quiz module](#) are enable as well as the [Theming module](#) with the 'quizcreation' feature turned on.

### Launch quiz editor

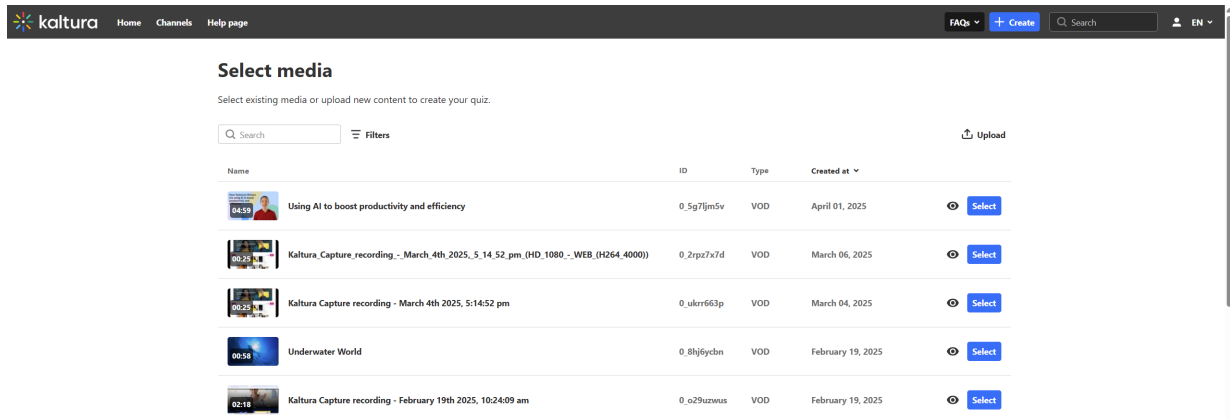
You can launch the quiz editor in one of the following ways:

#### From the Video Portal

1. Click the **+Create button** and select **Video Quiz**.



The **Select media** page displays.



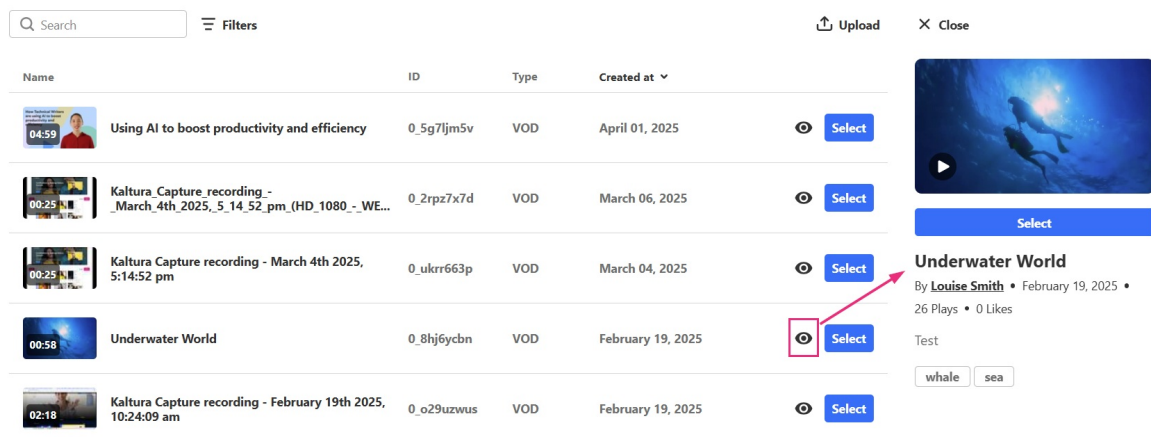
You can use the search field and filters to quickly find the media item you need.

2. Click **Select** next to the item you want to use for your quiz.

You can click the **eye icon** to preview the media - press play to watch, then click **Select** or **Close** to exit the preview panel.

### Select media

Select existing media or upload new content to create your quiz.

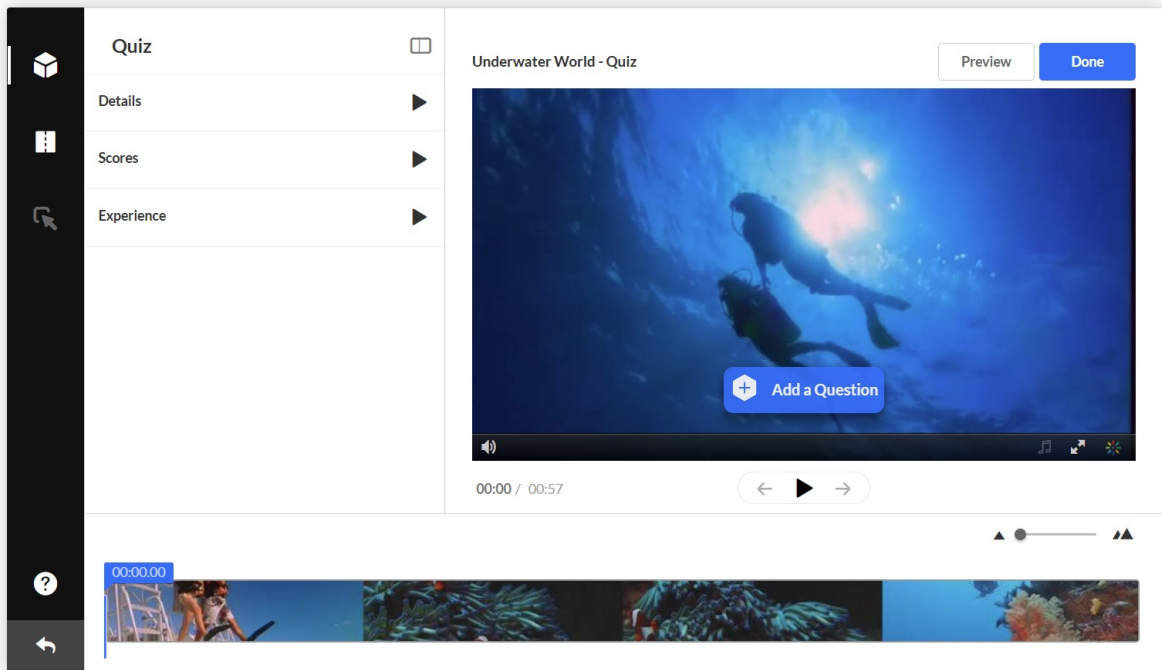


If you want to upload a new media item for the quiz, click **Upload** at the far right. See [Upload media](#) for instructions if needed.



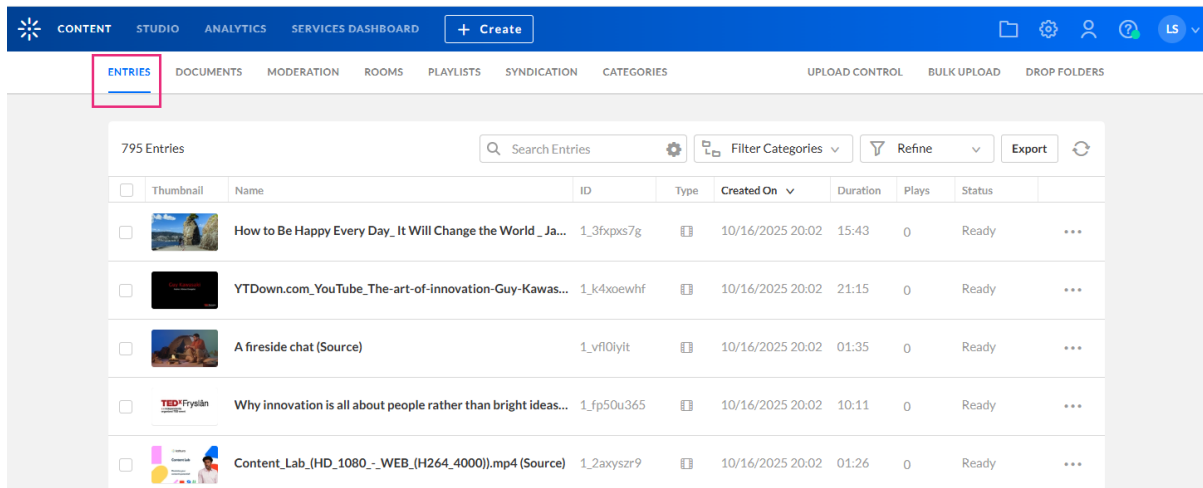
You can create or modify a quiz from VOD, audio, and YouTube entries, but not from Live entries or images.

Once you click **Select**, the quiz editor launches.

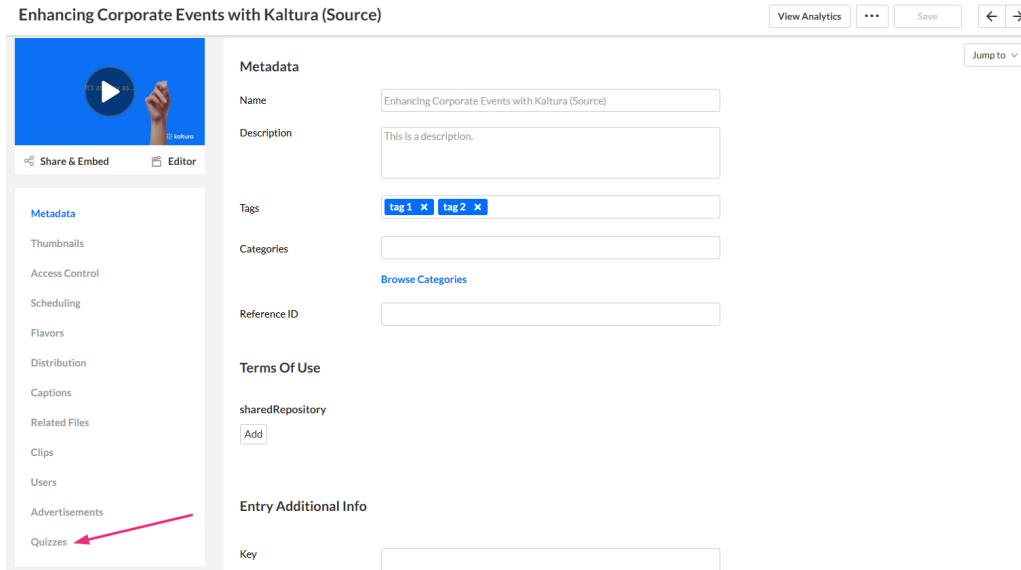


## From the Rich Media Content Management System

1. Log into your Rich Media CMS.  
The **Entries** page displays by default.

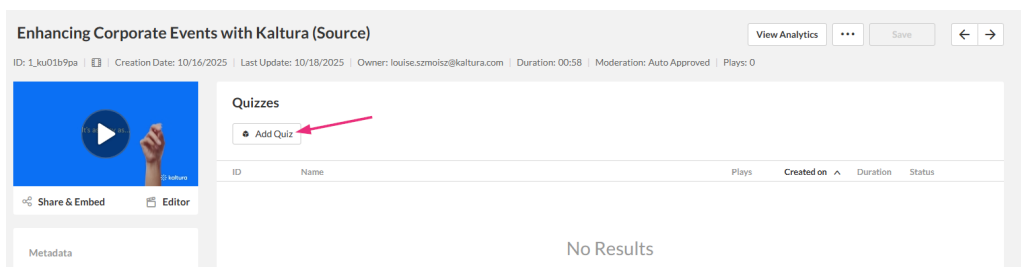


2. Click on the desired entry's title or thumbnail.  
The entry details page displays.
3. In the left panel, select **Quizzes**.



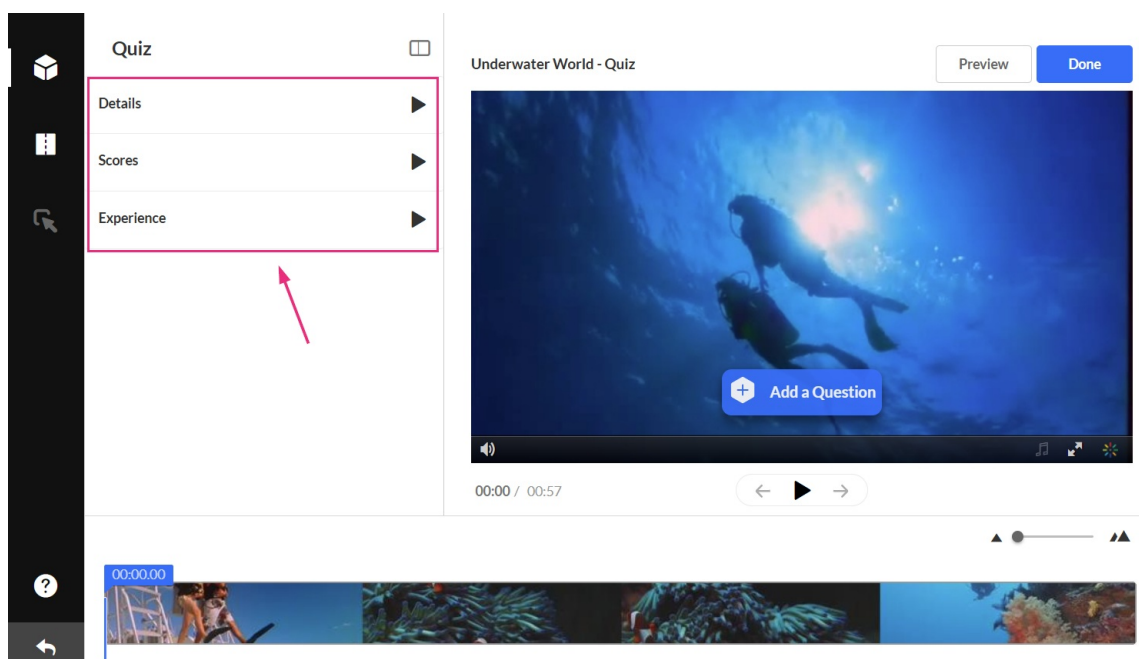
The 'Quizzes' tab opens.

Click **Add Quiz** to launch the quiz editor for that entry.



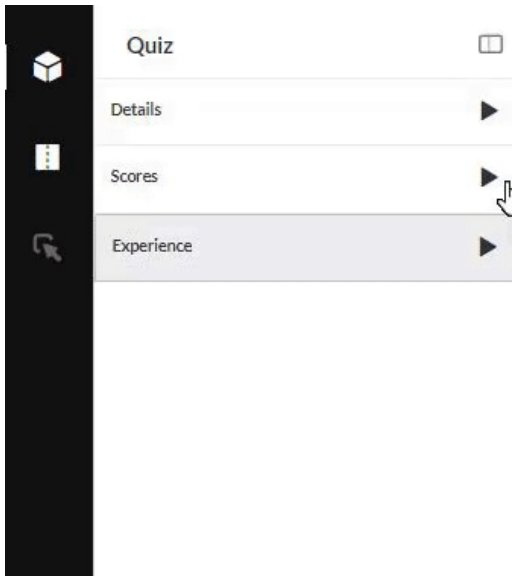
## Configure quiz settings

Quiz settings are organized into three tabs: **Details**, **Scores**, and **Experience**.



## Details tab

Use the **Details** tab to configure basic quiz information.

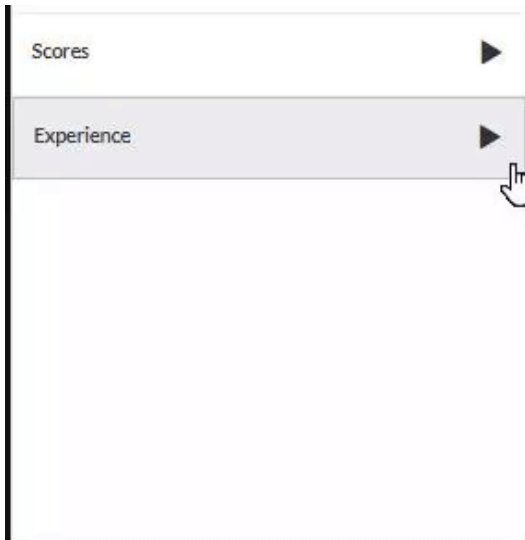


The following settings are available:

- **Quiz Name** - This is the name you originally gave to the media item. You can change it to any name you want.
- **Welcome Message** - A default message is ready for you to use but you can change it to anything you like. The message is shown on the first screen of the quiz. If you don't want a Welcome message, just untick **Show Welcome Page**.
- **Allow Download of Questions List** - This allows quiz participants to download the list of questions before starting the quiz. See our article on [Pre-test questions](#) to learn more.
- **Instructions** - The following default instructions will be displayed: "All questions must be answered. The quiz will be submitted at the end."

## Scores tab

Use the **Scores** tab to configure scoring options.



The following default values are displayed, and you have the option to change them:

**Allow Multiple Attempts** - You can select how many attempts a participant has to take the quiz (the minimum is two per quiz). You then choose which score to keep (highest attempt, lowest, latest, first, or average of all attempts).



The enableQuestionsV3 setting in the [Quiz module](#) must be enabled for the **Allow Multiple Attempts** feature.

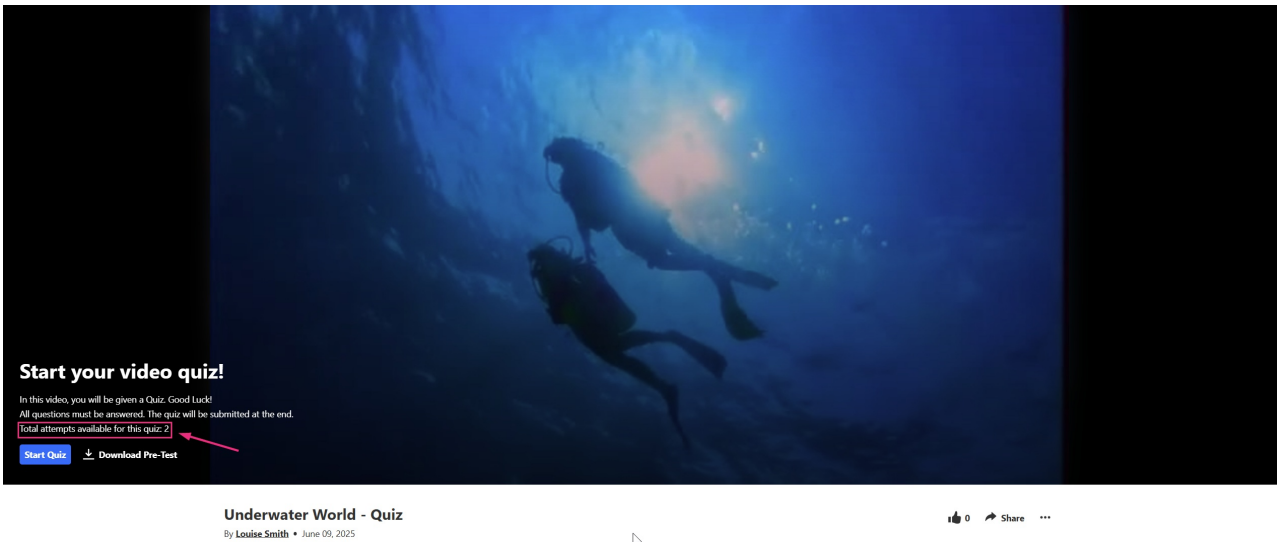

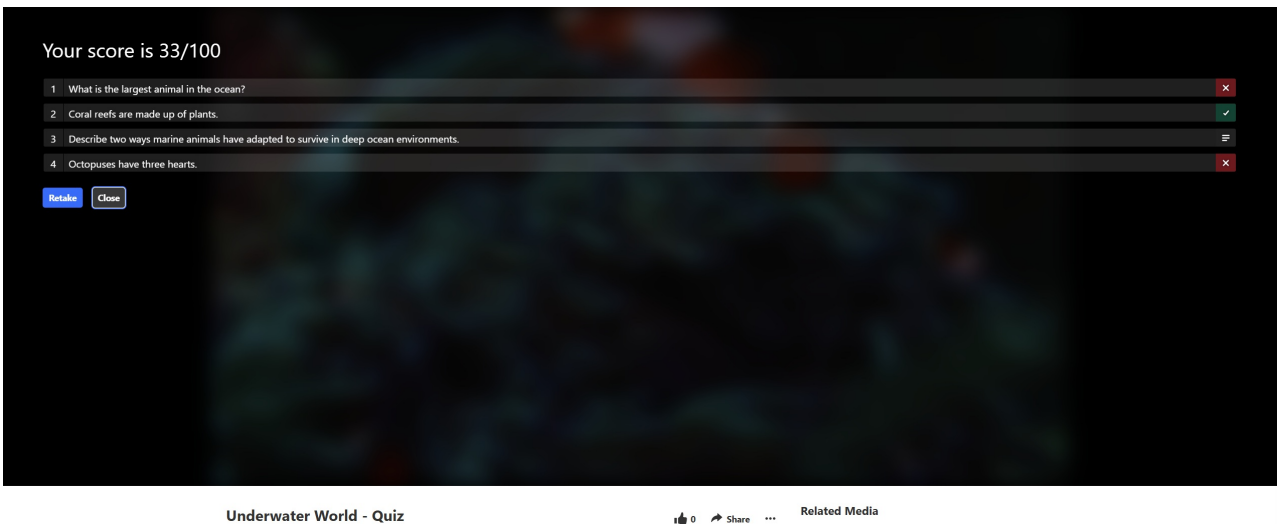

Quiz Score to Keep

If the **Welcome page** is enabled in the Details tab, the number of allowed attempts displays on that page.



After submitting the quiz, participants see the **Submitted** page, which displays the final score.



 If participants choose **Retake**, they cannot view their previous answers.

### Score visibility

You can choose how quiz results are displayed to participants:

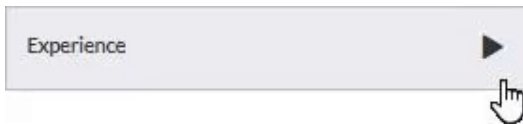
- **Do Not Show Scores** - A 'Thank you' message will display after submitting the quiz, and no scores will be presented to the viewer.
- **Show Scores** - Participants will see the quiz score page after the quiz has been submitted.
- **Include Answers** - Participants will be able to see correct/incorrect answers, as well as the correct answer's rationale if you chose to add it during the quiz creation.

If you change your mind, you can click **Revert to defaults** at any time.

## Experience tab

Use the **Experience** tab to configure how participants interact with the quiz.



The following default values are displayed, and you have the option to change them:

- **Allow Answers Change** - Allows your participants to change an answer before submitting the entire quiz during review mode.
- **Allow Skip** - This enables a "Skip for Now" button which allows your participants to skip a question and go back to it later.
- **Do not Allow Skip** - Participants must submit an answer before proceeding forward.
- **No seeking forward** - Participants won't be able to use the seek bar to navigate the video past the point they viewed.

Click **Revert to defaults** to restore the default experience settings.
