Keeping your media library organized and up to date is key to maintaining a high-quality learning experience. Over time, you may need to remove outdated or unnecessary content.

This guide shows how to delete media from My Media in your LMS. If needed, you can restore deleted items from the Recycle Bin (if enabled).

You cannot delete published media. You must unpublish it before you can delete it.

Delete a single item



If you cannot access your My Media page content/actions or display editing tabs, ask your administrator to give you the required permission.

1. Access the **My Media** page.





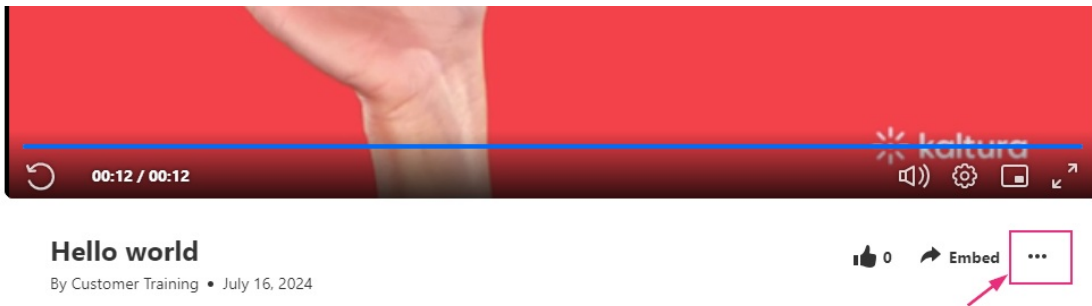

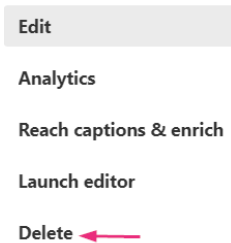

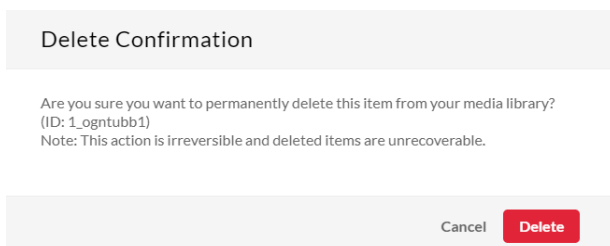


4. Click **Delete**.
