About

This guide explains how to add a Kaltura Interactive Video Quiz (IVQ) to your Moodle course and connect it to the gradebook.




Remind students to complete their quiz in one sitting. If a quiz is left open for several hours or days, the browser session may expire and grades may not sync to the LMS gradebook. Encourage students to avoid long breaks or switching devices while taking the quiz.

Add your quiz to Moodle

- 1. Create a video quiz in your My Media. (See Kaltura Video Quiz in Moodle for details.)
- 2. Go to your course.
- 3. Under the topic where you want the quiz, click the blue Add an activity or resource button.






- 4. What you do next depends on your Moodle version:
- If you're using **Moodle 3.x**: Select **External Tool**, then click **Add**. In the Preconfigured Tool menu, choose **Kaltura Video Quiz** (or your custom tool name).
- If you're using **Moodle 4.x**: Simply select **Kaltura Video Quiz** from the Activities list.

The Kaltura media library opens.

5. Find the video quiz and click **Embed**.

6. Set your grade settings

The Scale option is not supported - use points.

7. Adjust any other configuration as needed, then click **Save and display**.

When students take and submit their quiz (see A user's guide to taking Kaltura video quizzes for more help), their grades are automatically sent to the Moodle Gradebook for that assignment.
