- Likes, plays & comments To the right of the title, you can like or unlike the

- 'Create with AI' Use Kaltura's AI tools to enrich or repurpose your content. Click to access Content Lab functionality. This button will be active and enabled only on applicable entries. If you click the Create with AI button on an entry with no captions, you can easily navigate and order captions with a click of a button. See Create highlight clips with AI, Create quizzes with AI, Create a summary and chapters with AI, and Enrich metadata with AI for more information.
- Actions menu Click to see additional options for your media. For more information, see Actions menu.
- Viewing context Shows where the entry is published.
