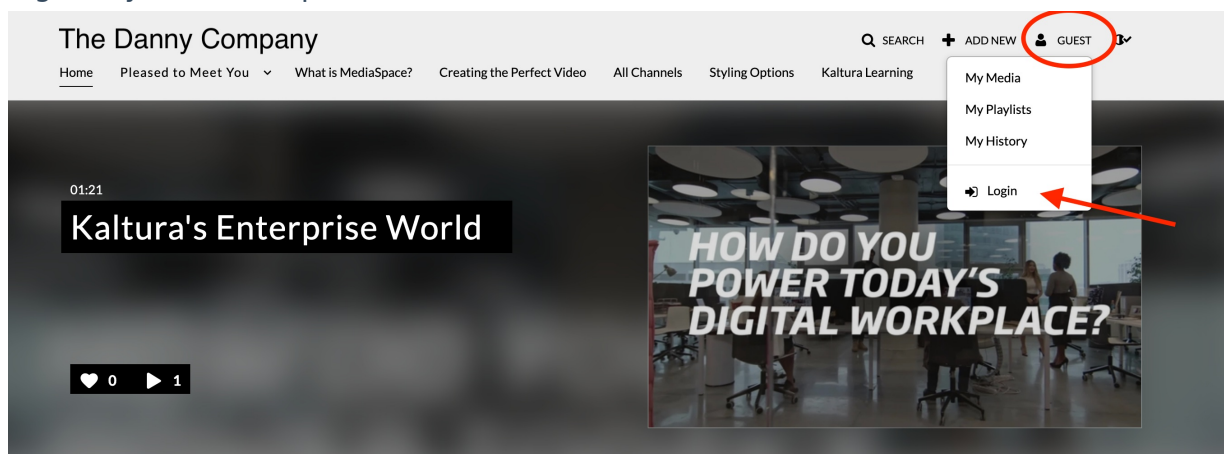

1. Login to your MediaSpace instance.



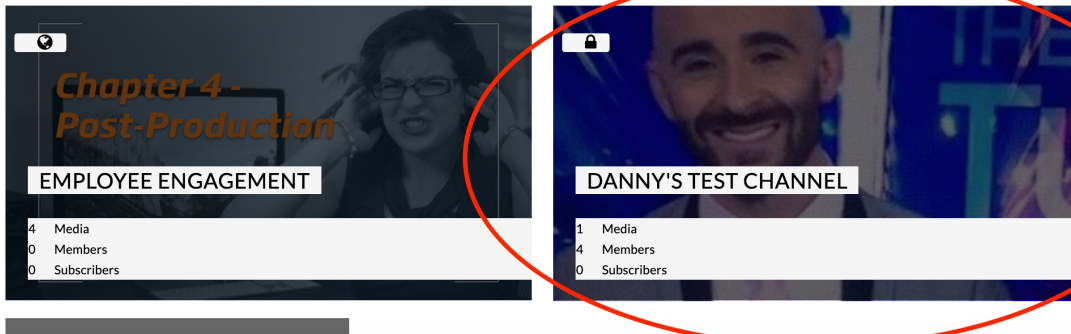
2. Select a channel.

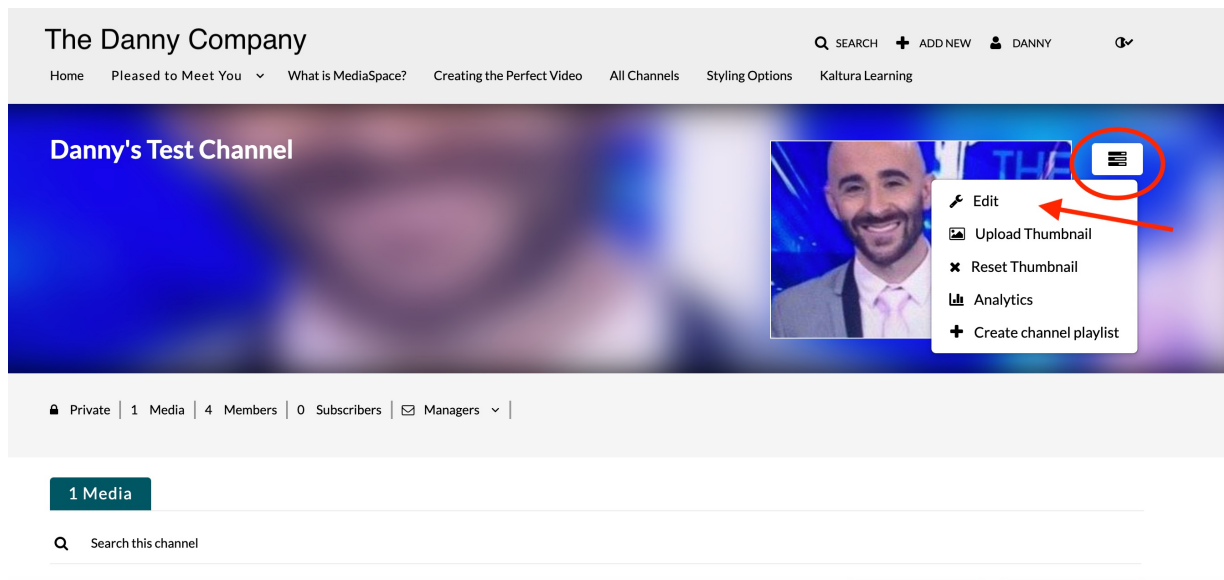
