About

Once you've configured an agent with a desired trigger and actions, you can activate or run the agent. This article will guide you through the process of activating or running an agent, depending on the type of trigger your chose for your workflow.

- Agents with **automatic** triggers (for example, when media is uploaded or when media enters a category) need to be activated. Once activated, they run automatically whenever the trigger condition is met.
- Agents with the **run on-demand** trigger must be started manually each time you want them to run.





Before you start


- Your account must have Publishing Agent enabled.
- If you want to use **REACH**-based actions (such as captions, translation, dubbing, moderation, audio description, chaptering and metadata enrichment), your account must have an active **REACH** profile and relevant catalog item(s) configured.

Access Publishing Agent

In the KMC, Publishing Agent is accessible via the **Agents** button on the top navigation bar.



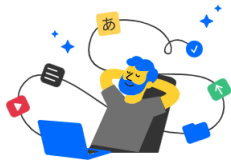
Click the **Agents** button and the 'AI Agents' screen displays. Your previously created agents are listed below the **Create new agent** button.



Activate an agent with an automatic trigger

For agents with automatic triggers, such as when media is uploaded or when media enters a category:


1. Click on the agent you would like to activate.

Your agent will be triggered when the entry turns to status 'ready'.
You can monitor its activity in the Agent Activity panel. Some actions may require your input.

Cancel **Activate**

3. Click **Activate** to confirm.

Once activated:

- When media is uploaded, the agent runs automatically every time an entry finishes processing and reaches 'Ready' status.
- When media is added to the selected categories, the agent runs automatically for each new entry.



If subcategories were included in the **trigger**, the agent runs for each entry that is added to subcategories.

After activation, the **Activate** button in the Overview tab updates to **Deactivate** (red), showing that the agent is currently active. You can click this button at any time to deactivate the agent.



Run an agent with an on-demand trigger

For agents with the run on-demand trigger:

1. Access the agents screen and click on the agent you would like to run.

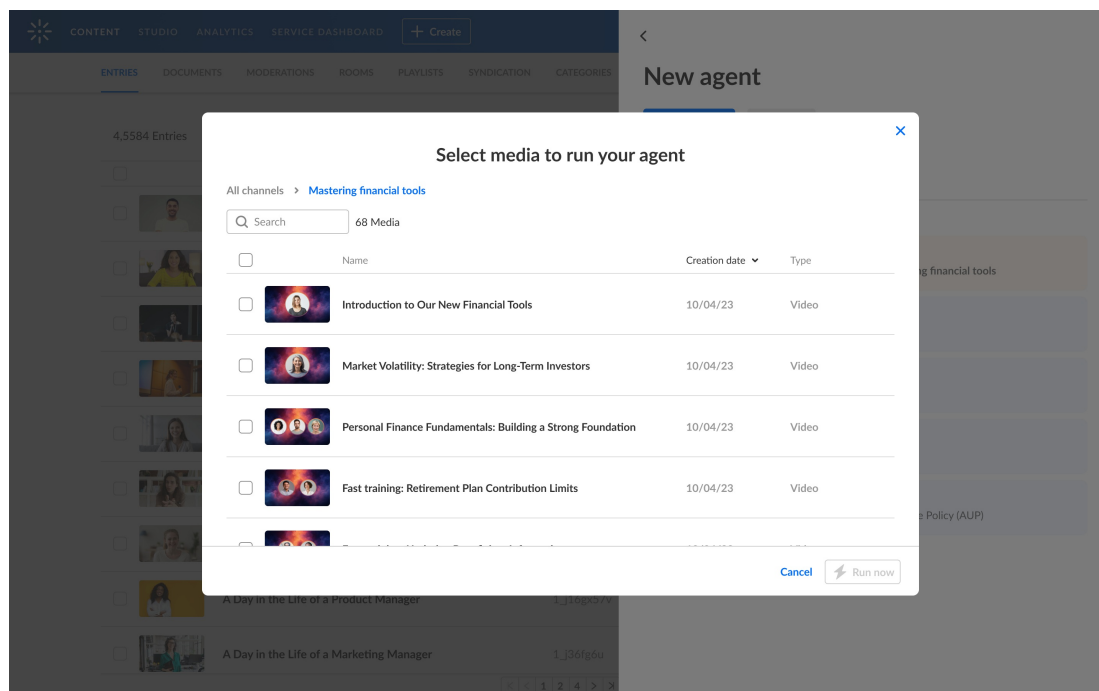

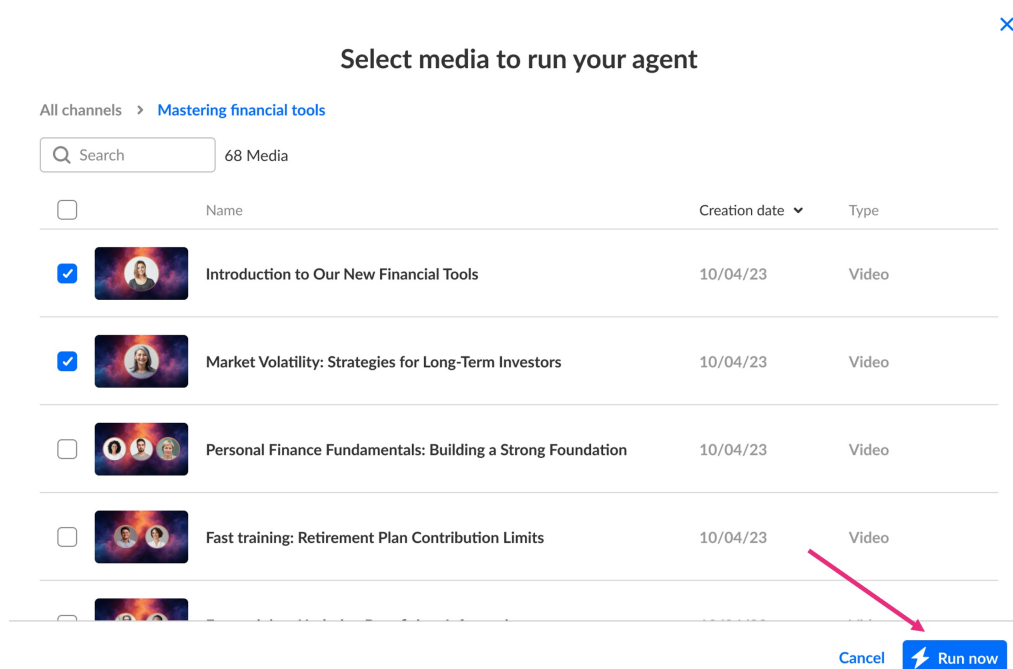


Only video and audio entries are supported.

3. Select one or more entries by checking the boxes.
4. Click **Run now** at the bottom right to start the agent. (The **Run now** button becomes active once at least one entry is selected.)




After running, you return to the **Activity** tab, where you can monitor the agent's

progress.



On-demand agents don't need to be activated or deactivated. The **Run** button always stays enabled, so you can run the agent again whenever you choose.
