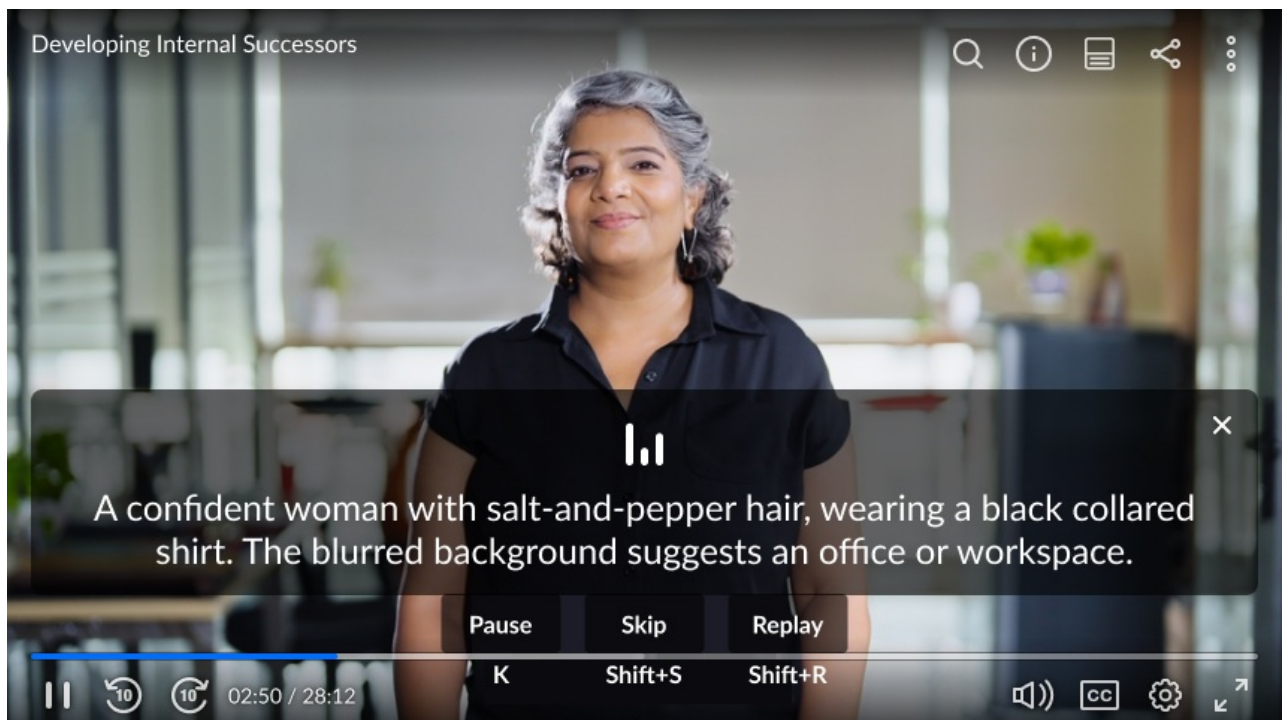

 The EAD plugin is not supported on live entries.

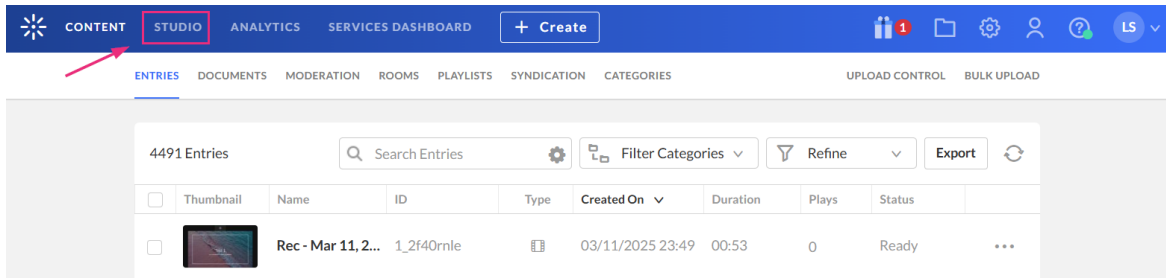
Example of EAD enabled, and full screen overlay disabled:

Access the player settings

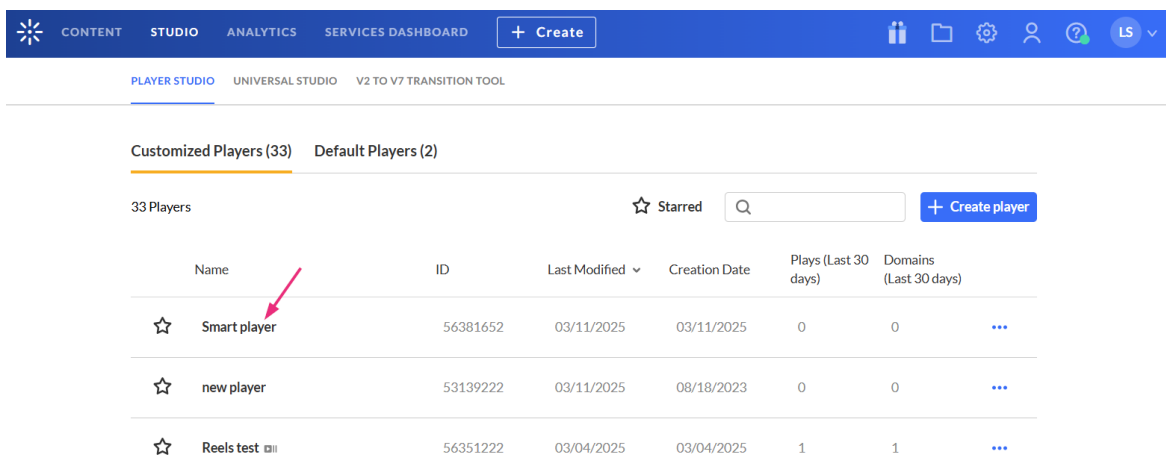
1. Log in to your [Rich Media CMS](#) and click the **Studio** tab.

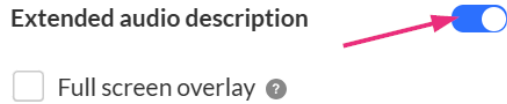

Set extended audio description

1. Scroll down to the **Accessibility & language** section, find **Extended audio description** and click the gear icon to open the settings.



2. Check **Full screen overlay** if you would like the description overlay to be shown in a full-screen mode.
