

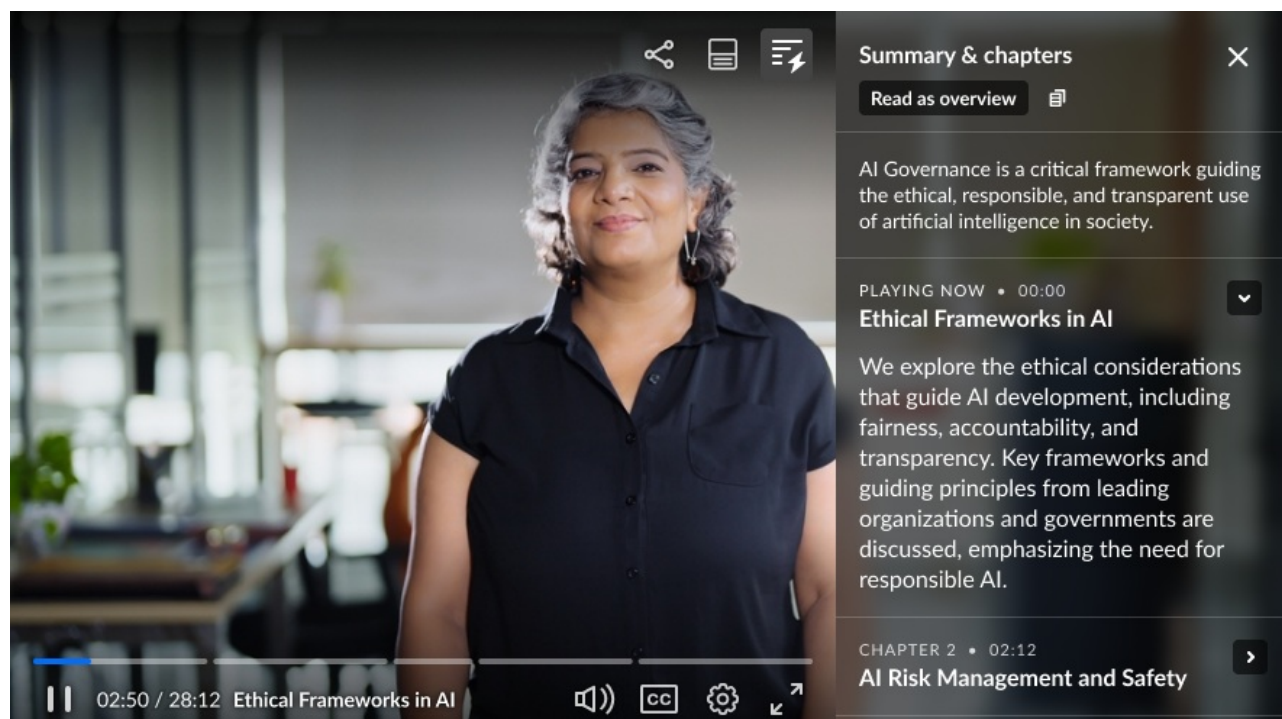

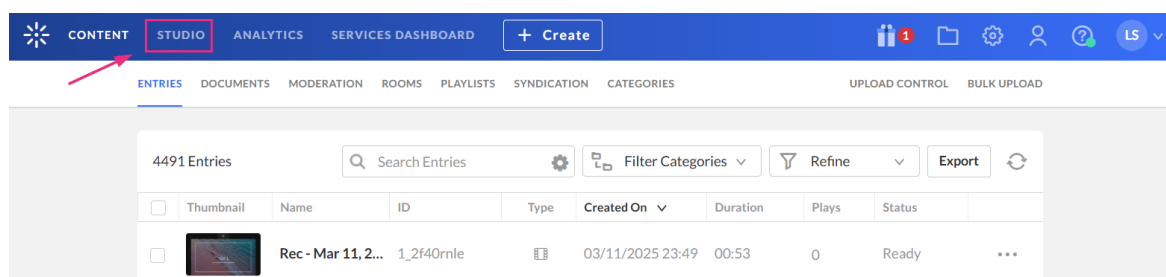

1. Log in to your KMC and click the **Studio** tab.


