## About

This guide walks you through downloading and installing Kaltura’s desktop recording app, Capture, on Windows.

These instructions apply to the legacy **LMS Video** integration. If you’re using LMS Video with Theming, please refer to the [LMS Rich Media Extensions category](#).

## Where to find Capture

Capture isn’t available in app stores or public download sites - you download it directly from your institution’s LMS. Once your system administrator enables the app in the [Kalturacapture module](#), it appears in your site.

If you have trouble finding or downloading Capture, contact your institution’s IT department or faculty support team.

## Download Capture

1. Access the **My Media** page in your LMS.
2. Go to the **+Add New** menu and select **Kaltura Capture**.

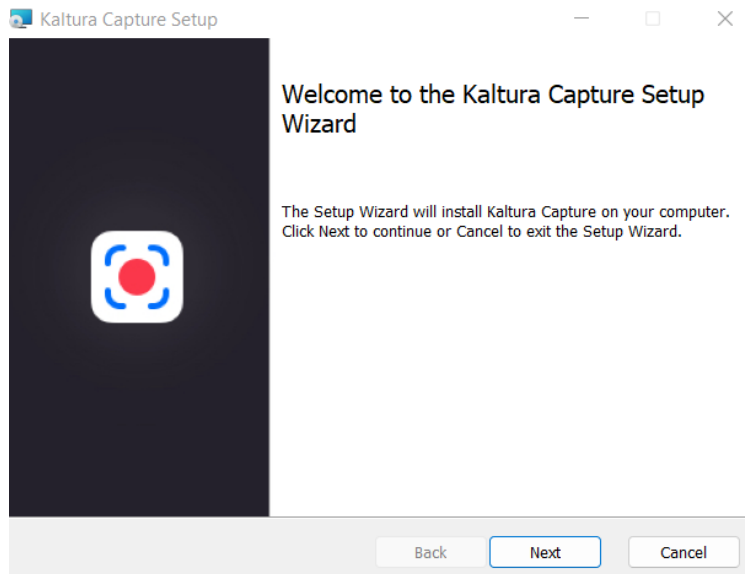
## Having trouble downloading Capture?

- **For IT administrators:** To avoid install issues, we recommend deploying Capture via software management tools like SCCM. See [Managed deployment of the Capture application](#).

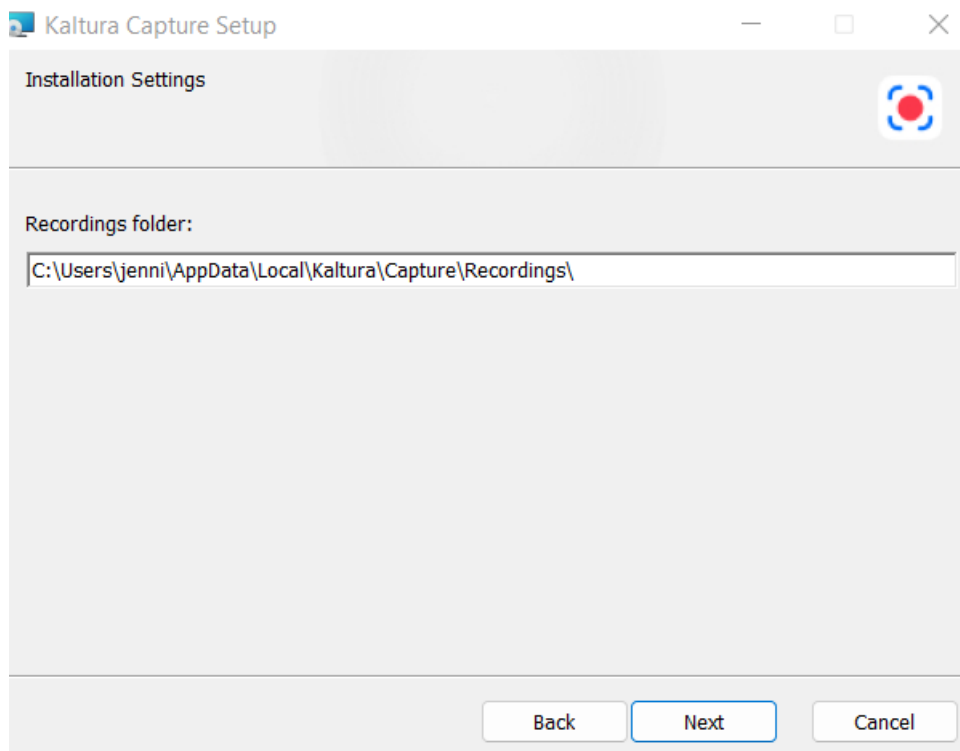
## Install

1. In your downloads folder, find the **KalturaCapture** file and click **Open File**. The **Welcome to the Kaltura Capture Setup Wizard** screen displays.

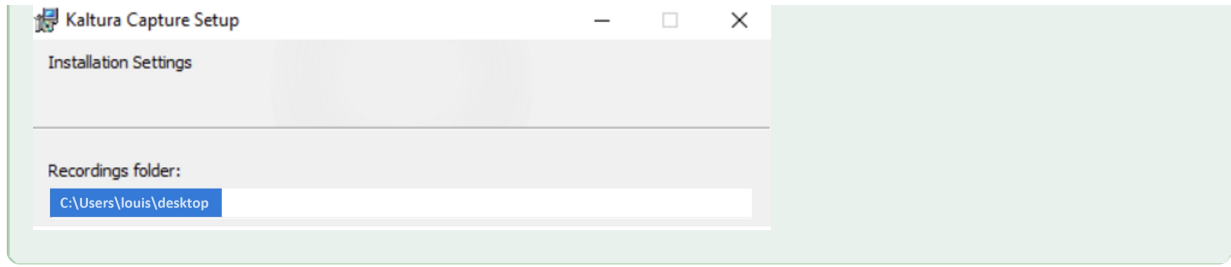


2. Click **Next**.

The **Installation Settings** screen displays.

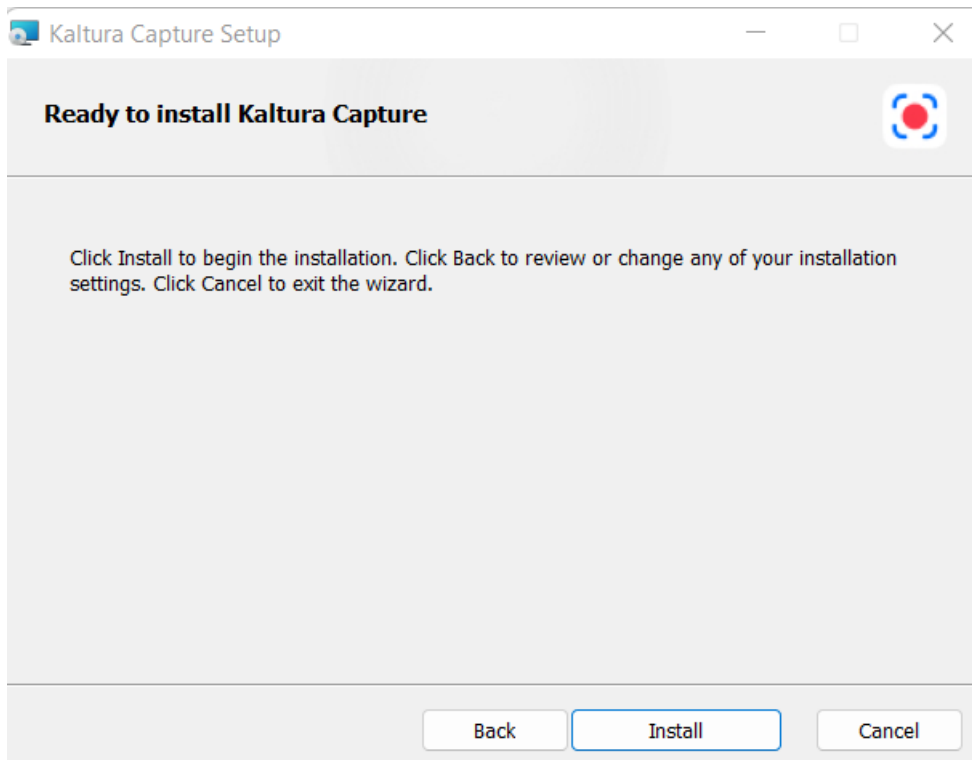


You can change the recordings folder to a more accessible location for easier access or deletion of files. To do this, remove the path information after your username in the Recordings Folder field and enter the new location, such as "desktop".



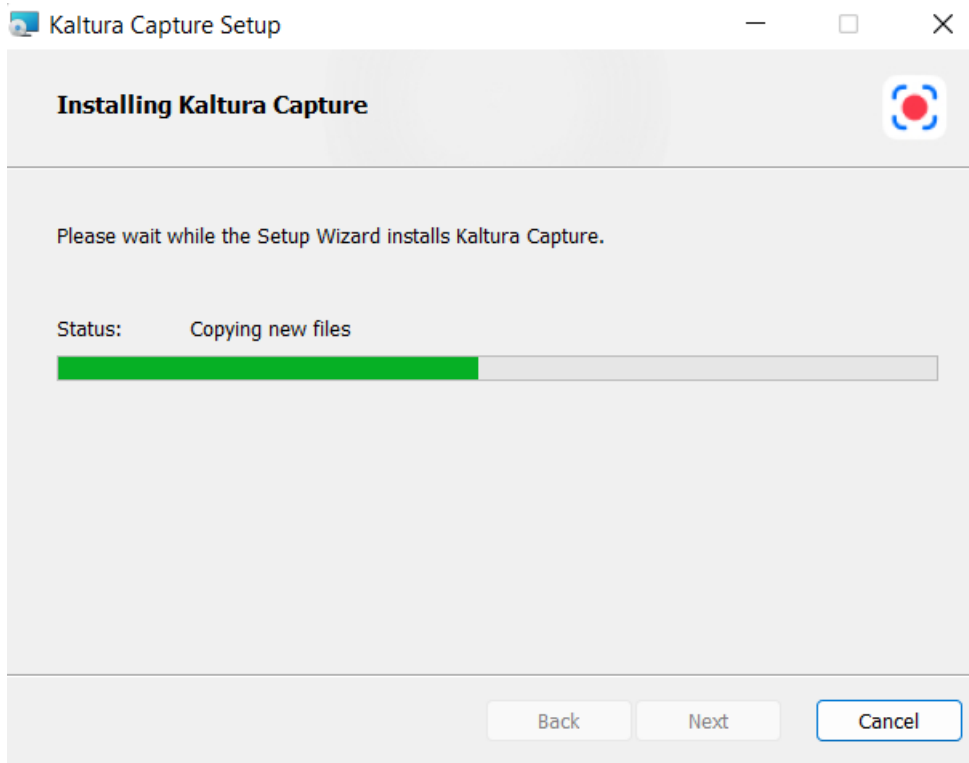
3. Click **Next**.

The **Ready to install Kaltura Capture** screen displays

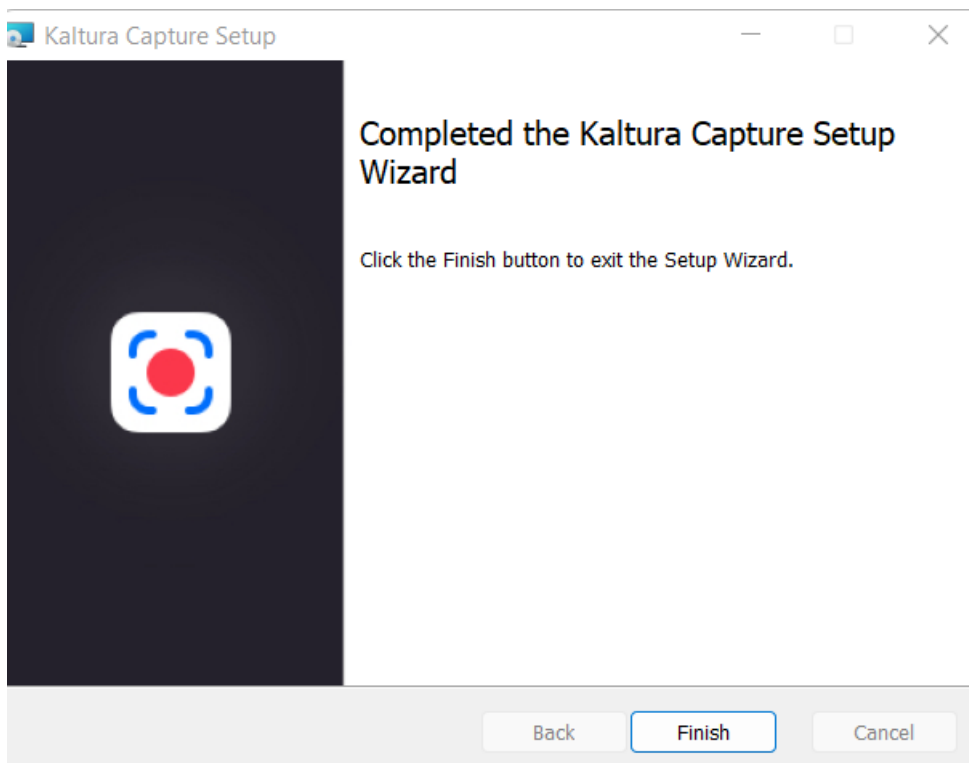


4. Click **Install** to begin the installation.

## Having trouble installing Capture?

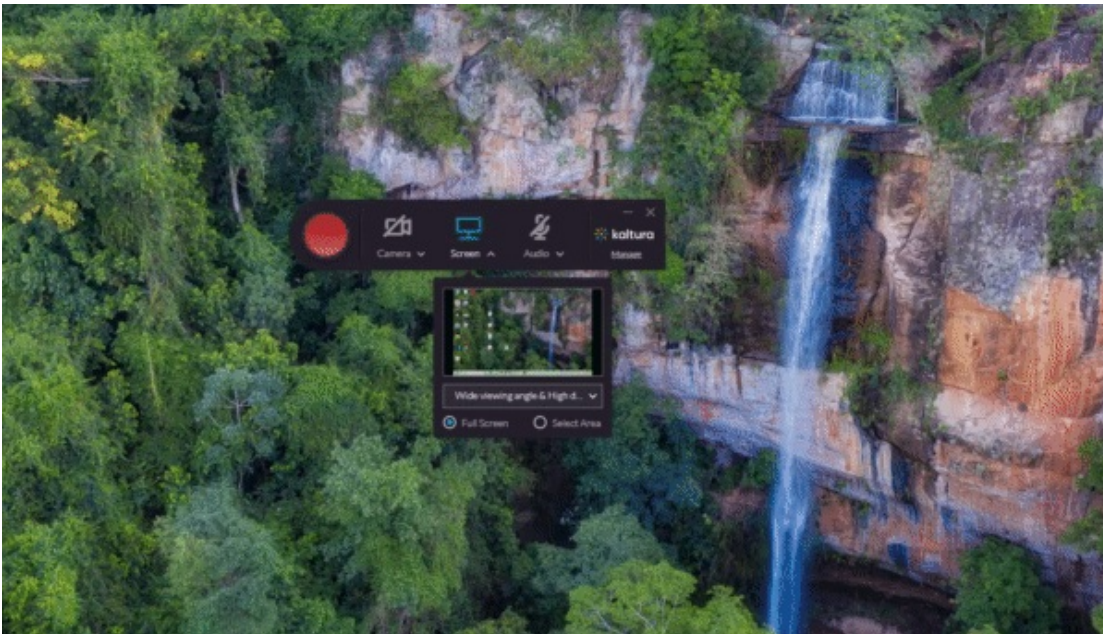

## Record

To start recording, simply select Capture from the **Add New** menu.

The application opens on your screen.

You can grab and move the position of the recording tool.



Click the red button to start your recording.

## Troubleshooting Capture

### Error messages

If you see error messages when trying to start or stop a recording, ensure that Capture

has permission to access your camera and microphone. After adjusting permissions, restart your computer and try again.

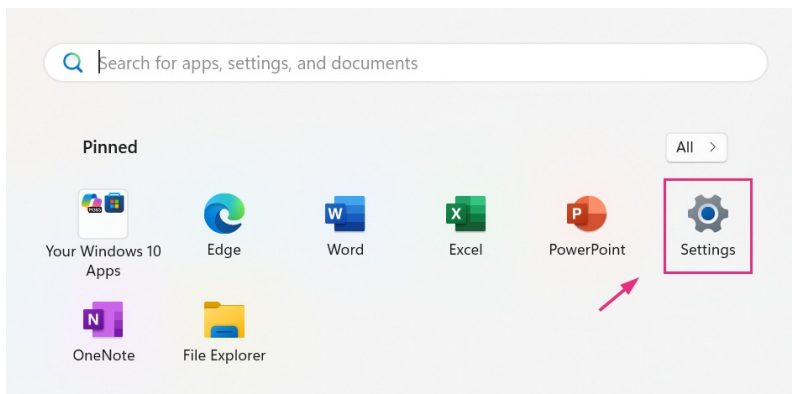

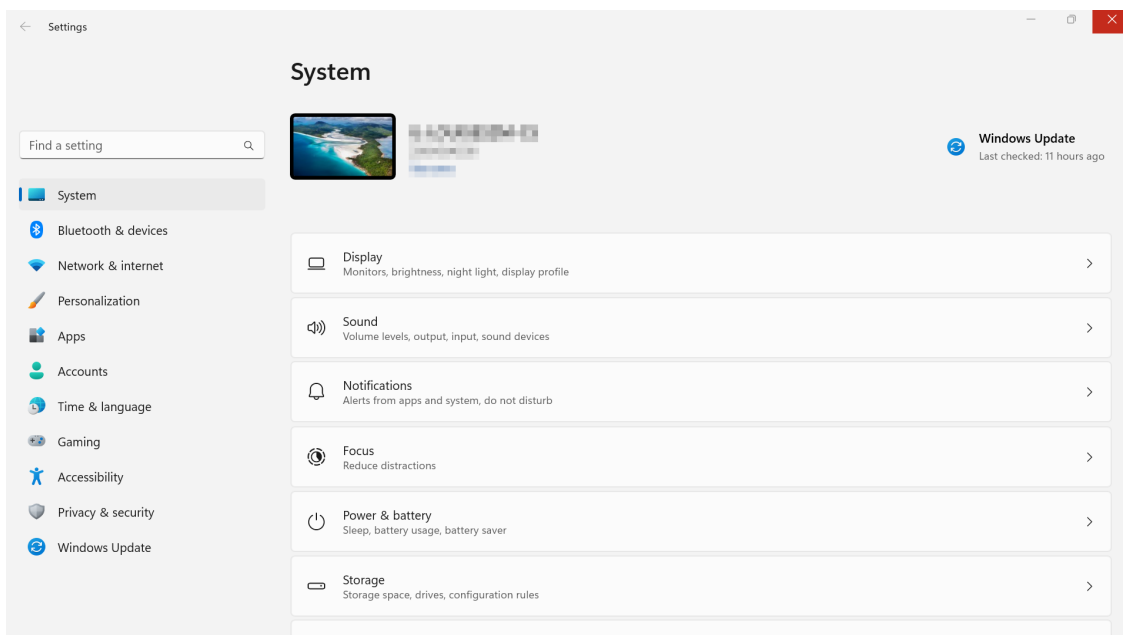
## Enable permissions

### Enable camera access

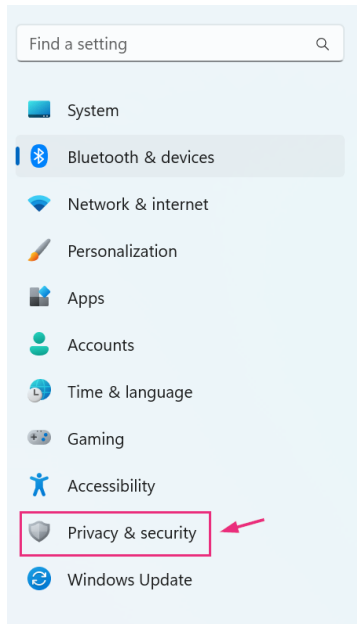
1. Open your Windows settings by clicking the Start menu and clicking the **Settings icon** (or press Windows + I on your keyboard), or by right-clicking the Start icon and selecting **Settings** from the menu.



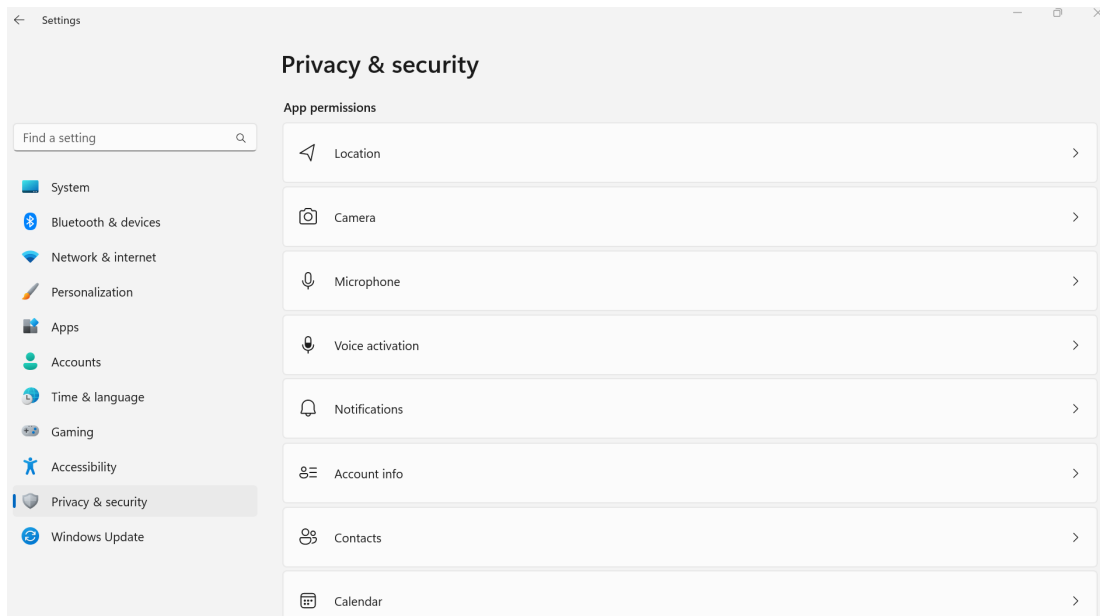
The System page displays by default.



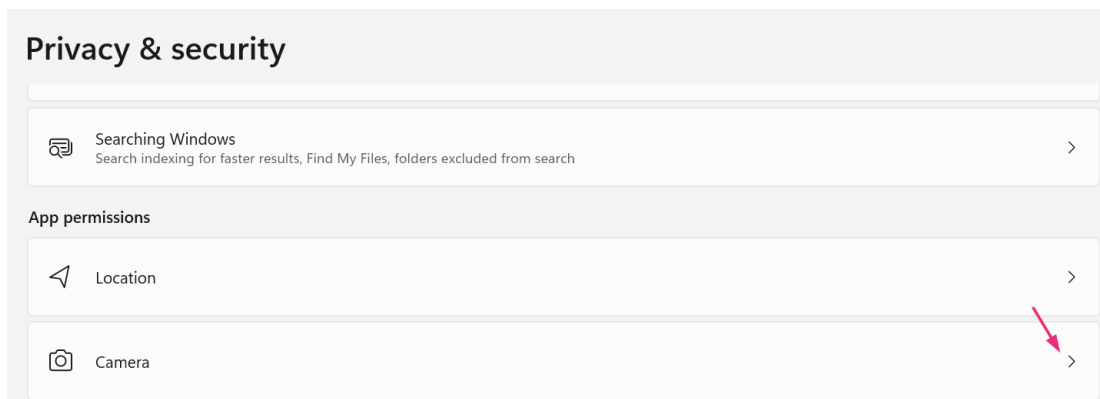
2. In the menu on the left, click **Privacy & security**.



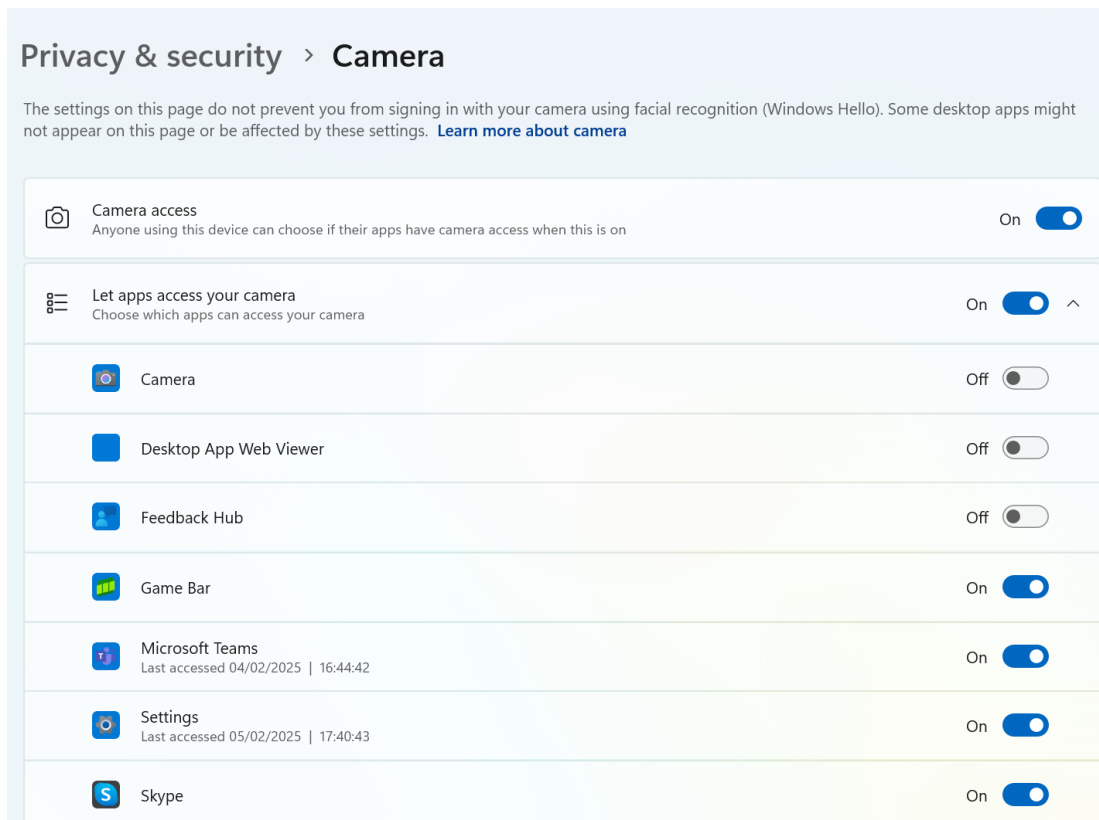
The Privacy & security list displays.



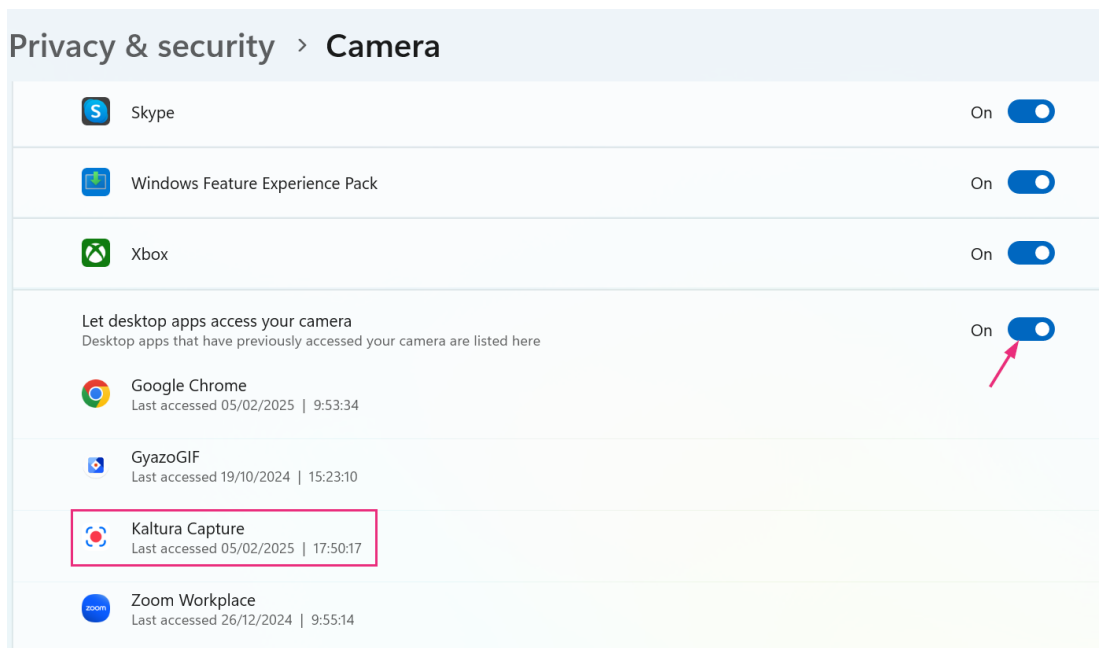
3. Scroll down to **Camera** in the list and click it to open its settings.



The Camera settings display.



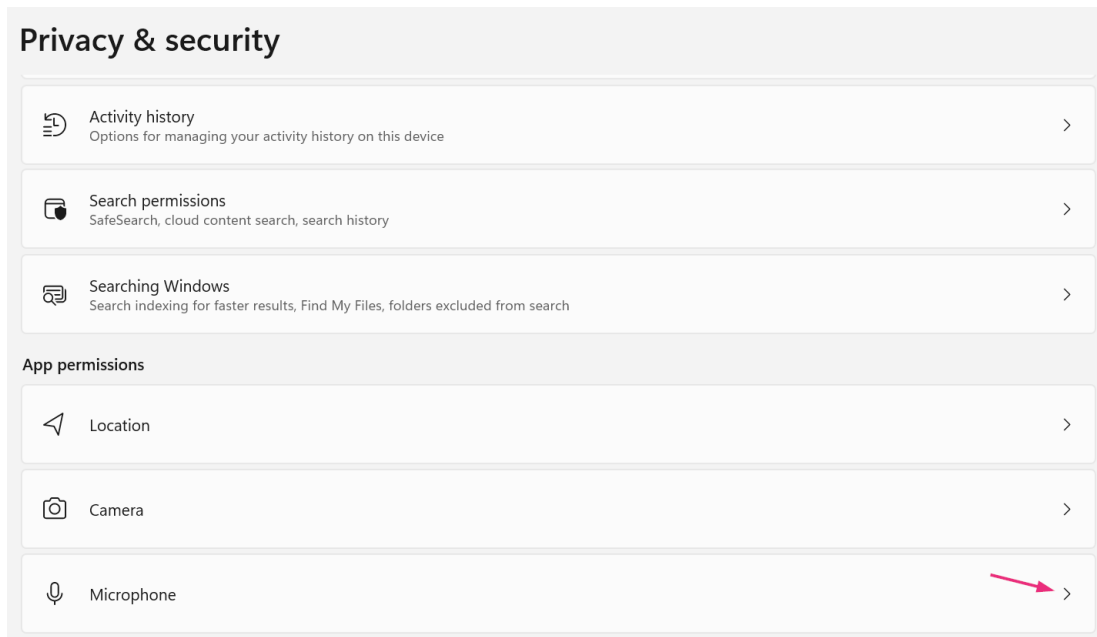
4. In the Camera settings, scroll down to **Let apps access your camera** and confirm that **Kaltura Capture** is listed and enabled.



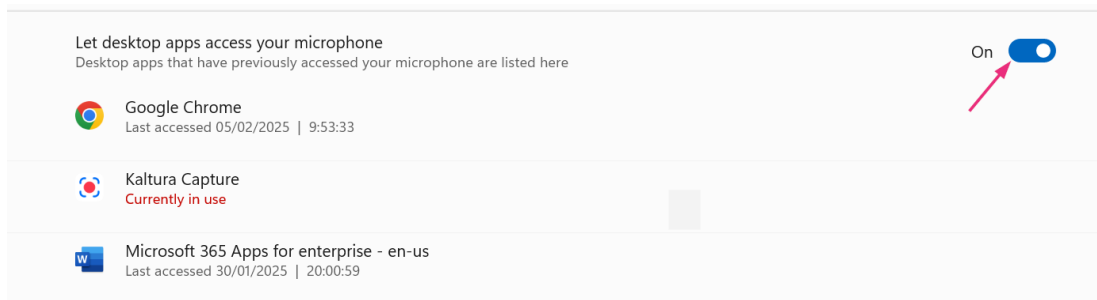
## Enable microphone access

1. Follow steps 1 - 2 above.

2. In the Privacy & security list, click **Microphone**.



3. Scroll down to **Let apps access your microphone** and confirm that Kaltura Capture is listed and enabled.



You may have to restart your computer for the changes to take effect.
