

# Order extended audio description (EAD) in Video Portal

## About

You can order **extended audio description** (EAD) for videos with limited natural pauses or dense visual content. EAD pauses playback to insert detailed narration of visual elements, then resumes the video when the narration is complete.

EAD uses speech synthesis to generate narration from a time-coded VTT file. Most browsers support speech synthesis, but some may not. To check browser compatibility, visit [lambdatest.com](https://lambdatest.com).



- Please contact your Kaltura representative to enable extended audio description on your account.
- Extended audio description requires a plugin in the Kaltura Player. To configure the plugin, administrators can visit our article [Extended audio description setup](#).
- Not supported in V2 player, mobile or non-VOD entries.

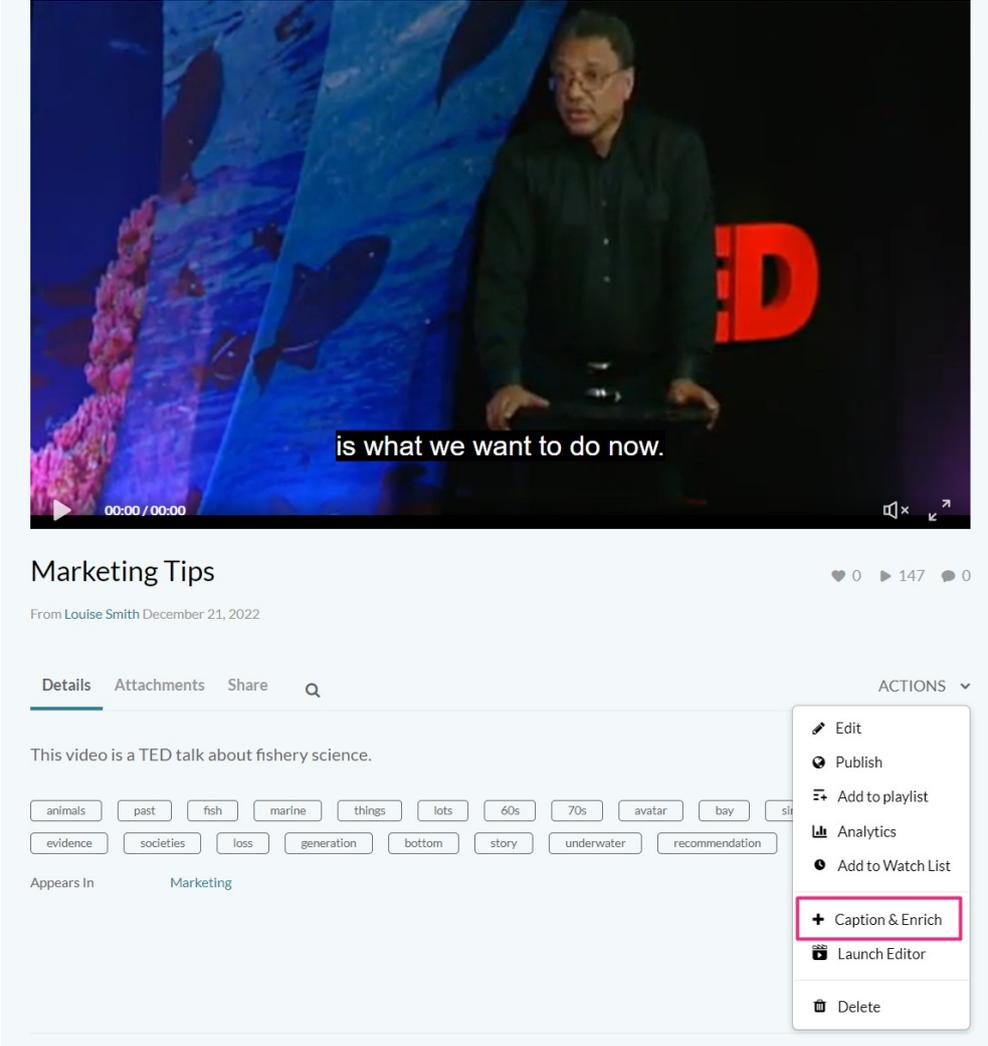

4. Complete the following fields:


- **Service** - Choose **Professional** as the Service. Audio Description is supported for professional service only and must be enabled by your system administrator.)
- **Source Media Language** - Select **English** from the drop-down menu. (This service is only available in English)
- **Feature** - Select **Extended Audio Description**.
- **Turnaround Time** - Select the turnaround time from the drop-down menu. (The TAT options are set by your administrator.)

5. Click **Submit**.




## Order for multiple videos

2. Select the media you want to order captions for by checking the checkbox next to each item.
