About


Channel owners can enable Genie in their channels to let users ask questions and discover content based on that channel's media. They can turn Genie on or off, depending on how the admin has configured it.


Enable Genie in a channel

1. From the user menu, select **My Channels**.




The **My Channels** page displays.




2. Find the channel you want to add Genie to and either click **Go to channel** button or the media thumbnail.



Channel Layout Choose the layout of your channel: Select 'Tabs' to display the channel elements (Sessions, Media, Playlists, About) in tabs. Select 'Vertical' to show the channel elements one above the other, allowing navigation between the elements with a scroll. We recommend to use the vertical UI only on channels with less than 100 elements (Sessions, playlist, Vods, etc.).


Links/CTA Select which CTA buttons/links to show. Between the 'Meeting', 'Chat', and 2 CTA buttons, only the first 3 will display on the UI in large screens, and only 2 in smaller screens. (Order by priority from top to bottom - 'Meeting', 'Chat', CTA1, CTA2)
 Display a custom link button.

 Enter the name that will be displayed on the button.


3. In the Channel layout section, choose **Tabs** or **Vertical**.

When the channel uses **Tabs** layout, an 'Ask anything' tab displays on the channel



4. Next, scroll down to **Sections**, and check the box next to **Genie** to display the 'Ask anything' experience on the channel page.
5. (Optional) In the **Default tab** settings, check the box next to **Genie** so that visitors land on the 'Ask Anything' tab when they open the channel.
