About

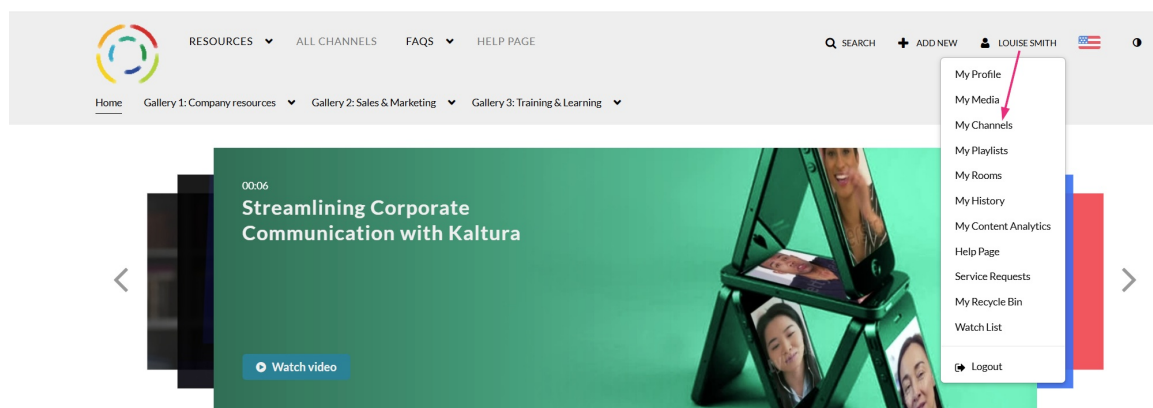
Channel owners can enable Genie in their channels to let users ask questions and discover content based on that channel's media. They can turn Genie on or off, depending on how the admin has configured it.

The **My Channels** page displays.

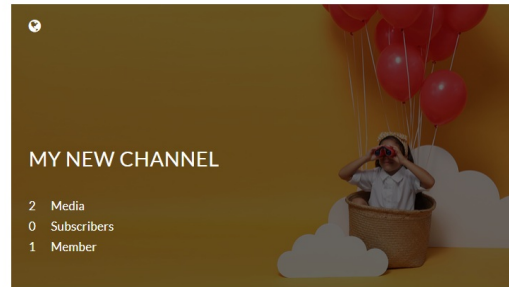
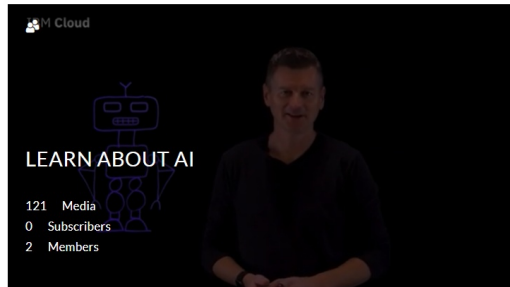

2. Find the channel you want to add Genie to and click the **pencil icon**.

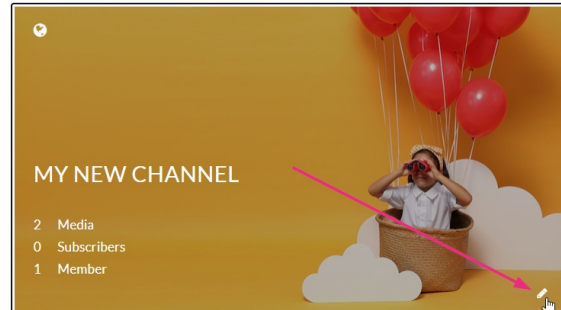
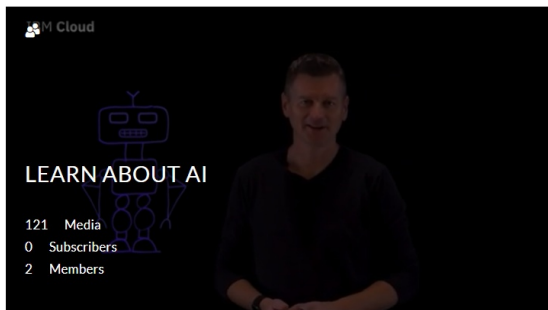


