About

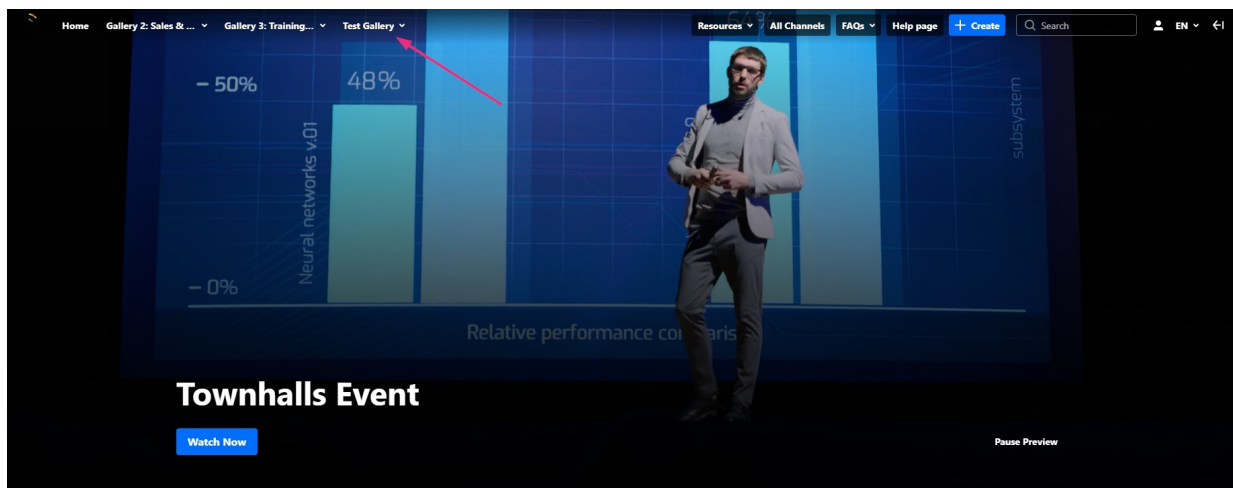
Gallery managers can enable Genie in their galleries to let users ask questions and discover content based on that gallery's media.

Access the gallery settings

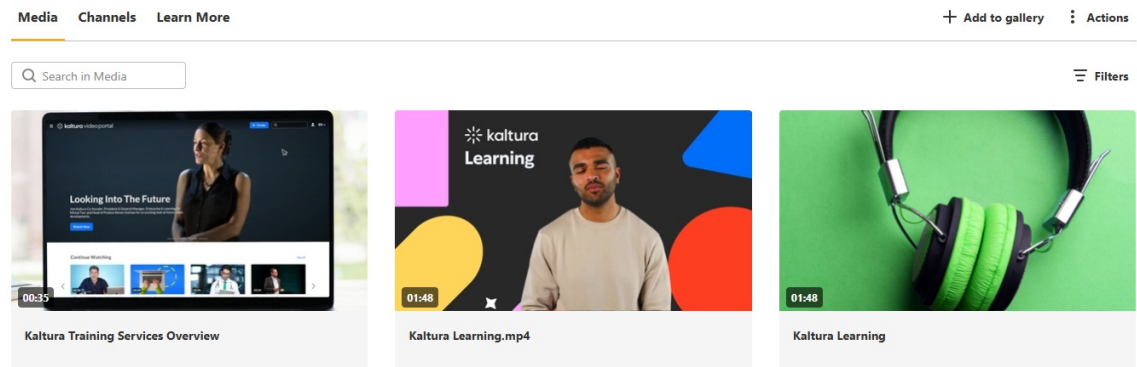
1. Select the gallery you want to manage from the navigation bar.



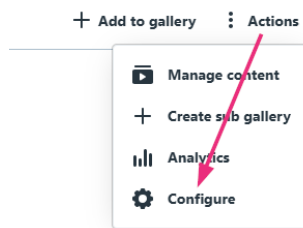

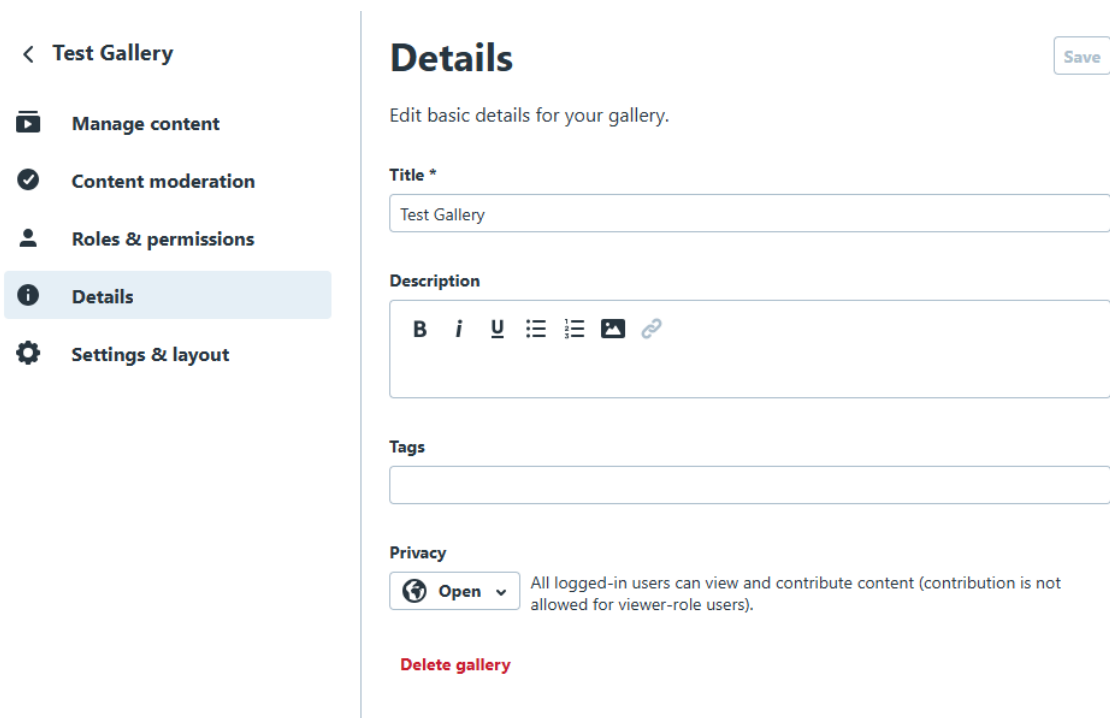

2. On the gallery page, click the **Actions** menu at the far right and choose **Configure**.




The edit page opens on the **Details** tab by default.



- Users can ask questions based on content within that gallery

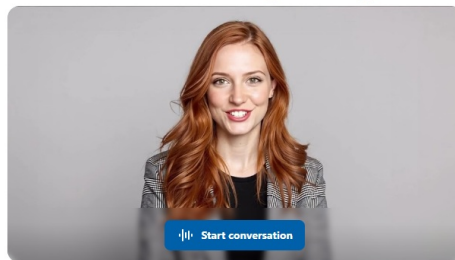


