

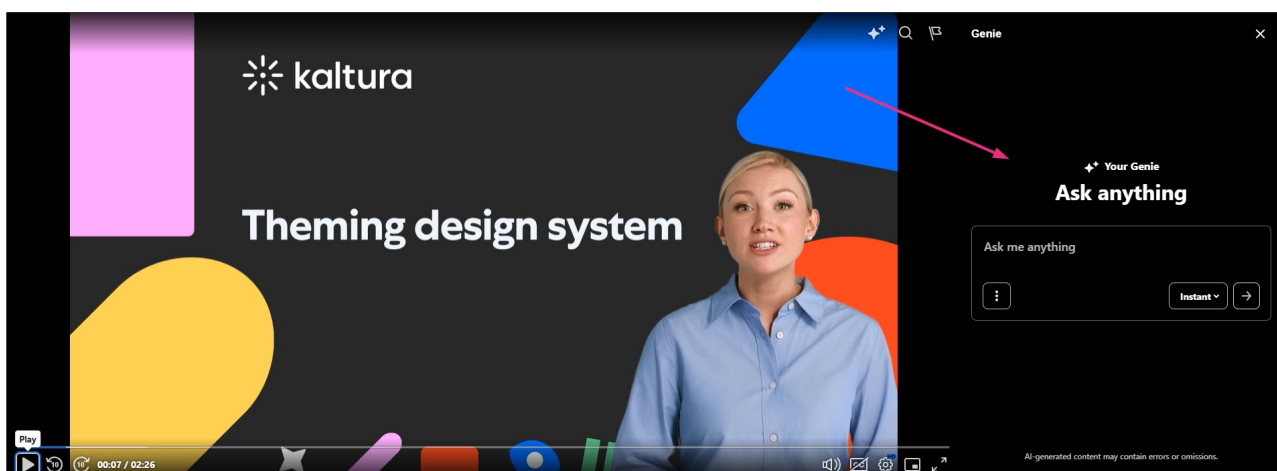

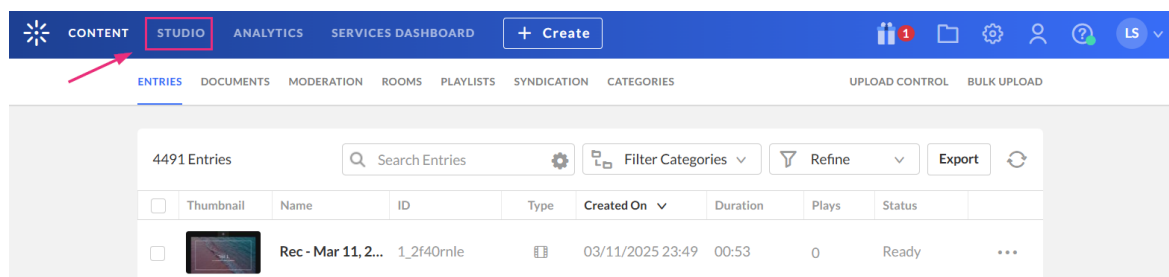
Single-video Genie adds an AI-powered chat panel to the player. Viewers can ask questions about the video and get contextual answers tied to the content they're watching.

Access the player settings

1. Log in to your KMC and click the **Studio** tab.




The **Player Studio** page displays.

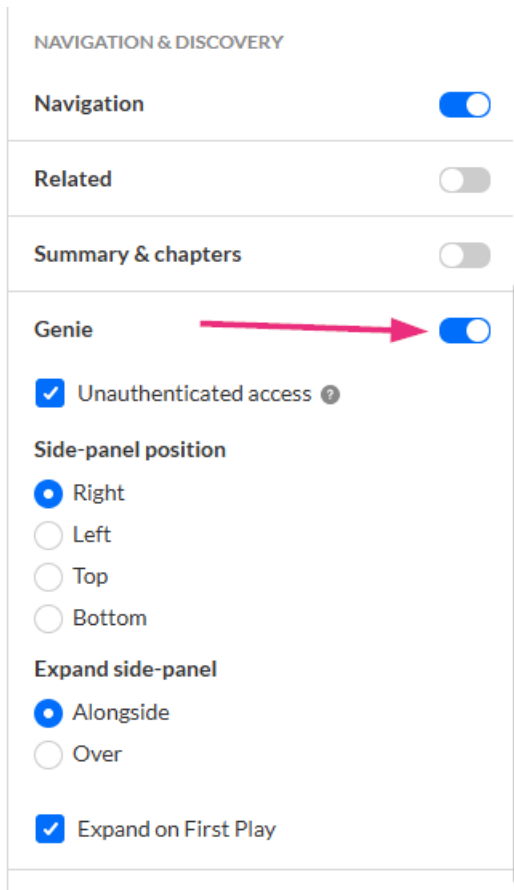

Enable Genie

1. Scroll down to **Navigation & Discovery**, locate **Genie** and turn on the toggle.



If Genie isn't enabled for your account, this toggle won't take effect. Contact your Kaltura representative to activate it.



2. (Optional) Configure additional settings:

- **Unauthenticated access** (default = on) - Lets unauthenticated users access Genie for the video they're watching.
- **Side-panel position** - Choose where the Genie panel appears on the player: **right, left, top, bottom**
- **Expand side-panel** - Choose how the panel opens when Genie is triggered - **alongside** or **over**
- **Expand on first play** - If enabled, the Genie panel automatically opens the first time the video is played. Viewers can close it at any time.

3. Click **Save** at the top right of the page.



Genie also appears in secure embedded players as long as the embedded player has the Genie plugin enabled.
