Instructors can enable **Genie** in their course media galleries to let students ask questions and discover content based on the videos and documents in that course.

If **Agentic Avatars** are enabled for your Genie configuration, students can also start a live avatar conversation within the media gallery's Genie experience.

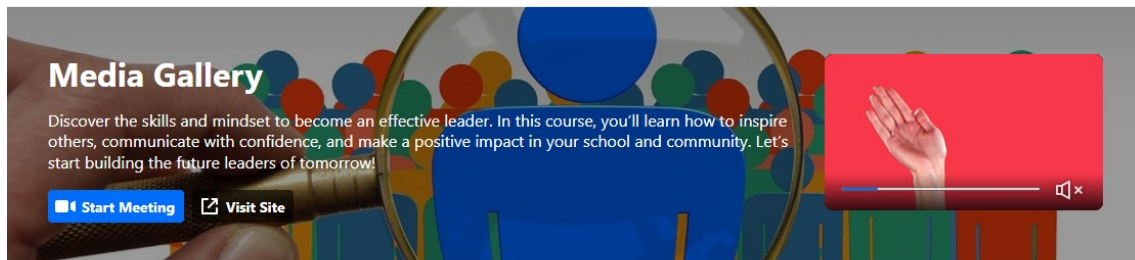

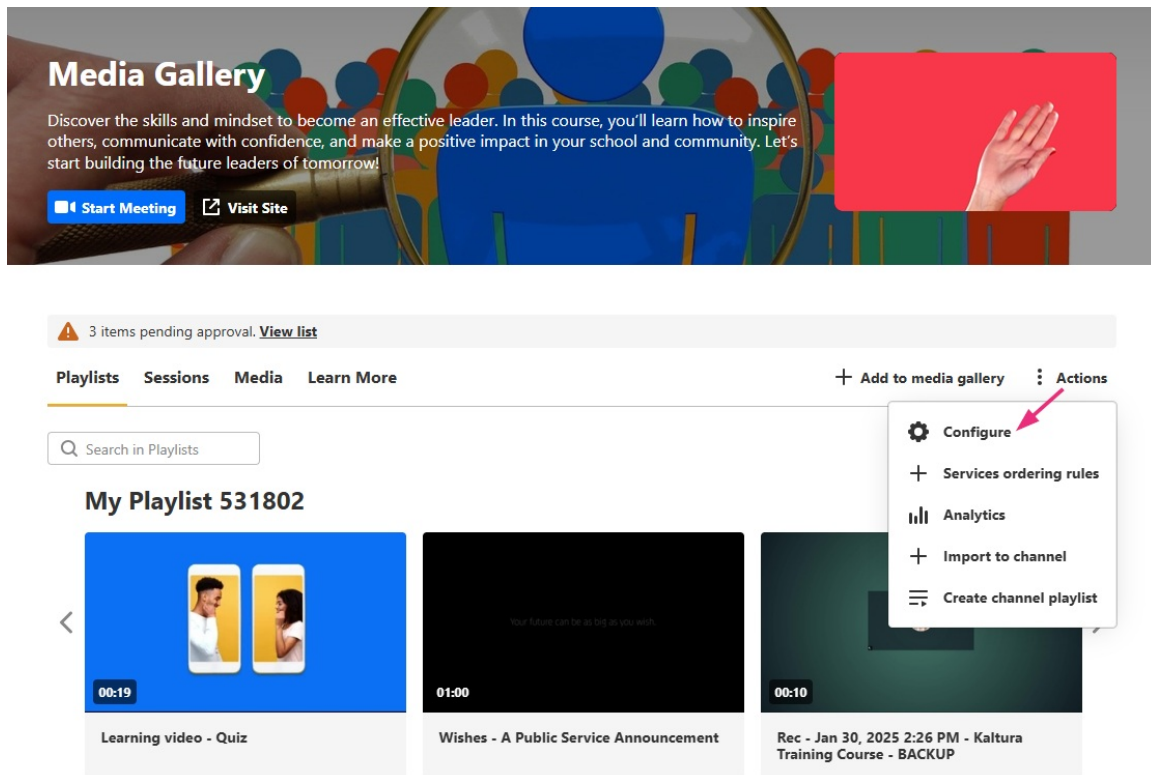

Channel Layout Choose the layout of your channel: Select 'Tabs' to display the channel elements (Sessions, Media, Playlists, About) in tabs. Select 'Vertical' to show the channel elements one above the other, allowing navigation between the elements with a scroll. We recommend to use the vertical UI only on channels with less than 100 elements (Sessions, playlist, Vods, etc.).

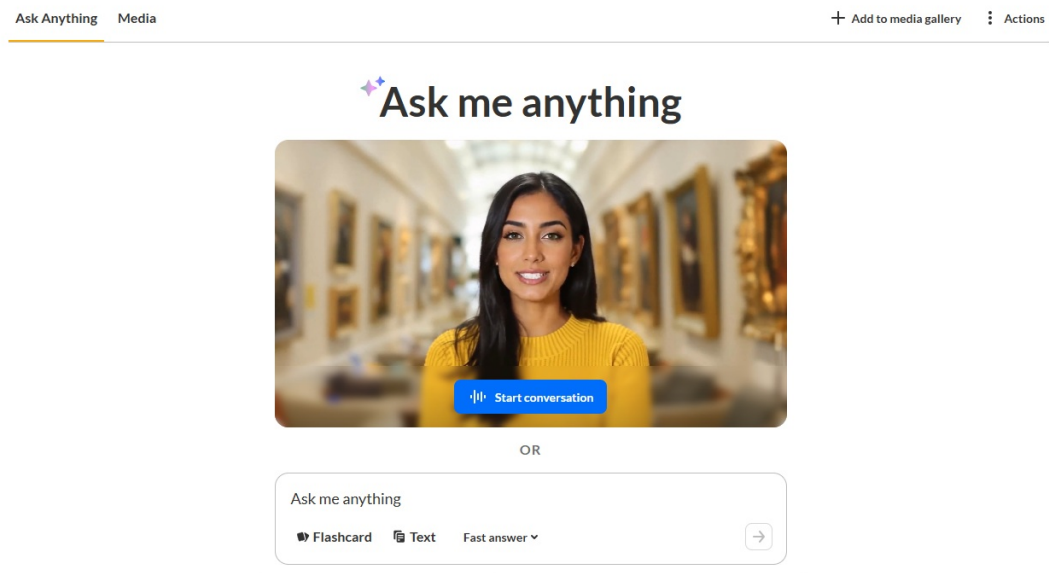
Links/CTA Select which CTA buttons/links to show. Between the 'Meeting', 'Chat', and 2 CTA buttons, only the first 3 will display on the UI in large screens, and only 2 in smaller screens. (Order by priority from top to bottom - 'Meeting', 'Chat', CTA1, CTA2)

Display a custom link button.

3. In the Channel layout section, choose **Tabs** or **Vertical**.

When the media gallery uses **Tabs** view, Genie appears as a new 'Ask anything' tab on the media gallery page.

When you ask Genie a question the results are presented in the context of that media gallery.




You can set Genie as the default tab so that visitors land on the 'Ask Anything' tab when they open the media gallery. This is managed in [Advanced settings](#) of

the edit page.

When the media gallery uses **Vertical** view, a Genie section appears on the media gallery page. The section includes a short description with an 'Ask Anything' button.


