





- Only players configured and made available by your administrator appear in the list.
- If only one player is available, the player selector is hidden and the default player is used.
- If a selected player is no longer available, the system automatically switches back to the default player.

You can select **Set as embed** player. When selected, this player is used when this media is embedded elsewhere. This option appears only when a custom player is selected.



*If you hide the **Title & Actions bar**, users will no longer see media title or actions (for example, **Share** or the **three-dot menu**).
