About

The **AddFromUrl module** lets users import media into [My Media](#) using a direct URL instead of uploading a file from their computer.

Once enabled, users can import **video**, **audio**, and **image** files from publicly accessible URLs. Kaltura automatically detects the file type and creates the appropriate media entry.



To make this option available to users, you must also enable **AddfromURL** in the [Theming module](#). This controls whether the *Import from URL* option appears in the **+Create** menu.



This module is available in both **Video Portal** and **LMS Video** and depends on the [Theming module](#).

Configure

1. Go to your Configuration Management console and click on the **Addfromurl** module. You can also navigate to it directly using a link:

https://{your_site_URL}/admin/config/tab/addfromurl.

Description

This module allows users to import media from a URL instead of uploading directly from their computer. Users will need to make sure that the URL used is a direct link to the file, and that the URL is accessible to all and not private or restricted.

Note

This is a KMS and KAF module. Depends on the **Theming** module.
