

About

This article explains how to configure seek behavior in the player, allowing you to control how viewers navigate during playback. When seek is enabled (i.e., [Prevent seek](#) is disabled), you can define the skip interval.

Access the player settings

1. Log in to your [KMC](#) and click the **Studio** tab.







Enable seek functionality

1. In the **Playback Options** section, find **Seek increments** and click the gear icon to enable the setting.



Seek increments 

10 seconds

Custom seek

- To select from one of two **preset seek increments**, click to select the first option, then click the down arrow and choose your desired increment - 5 or 10 (default).



The skip buttons will display the corresponding number (5 or 10) to indicate the amount of time the user can skip.

- To set your own **custom seek increment**, click to select "Custom seek", then type your desired increment. The skip buttons are displayed *without a number*, even though skipping is still enabled.

2. Click **Save** at the top right of the settings page.
