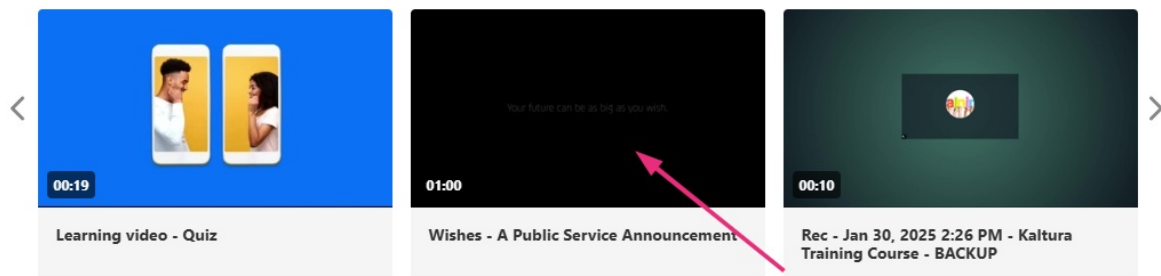
You can allow viewers to download your media in different formats.

- This feature requires the [Downloadmedia module](#) to be enabled.

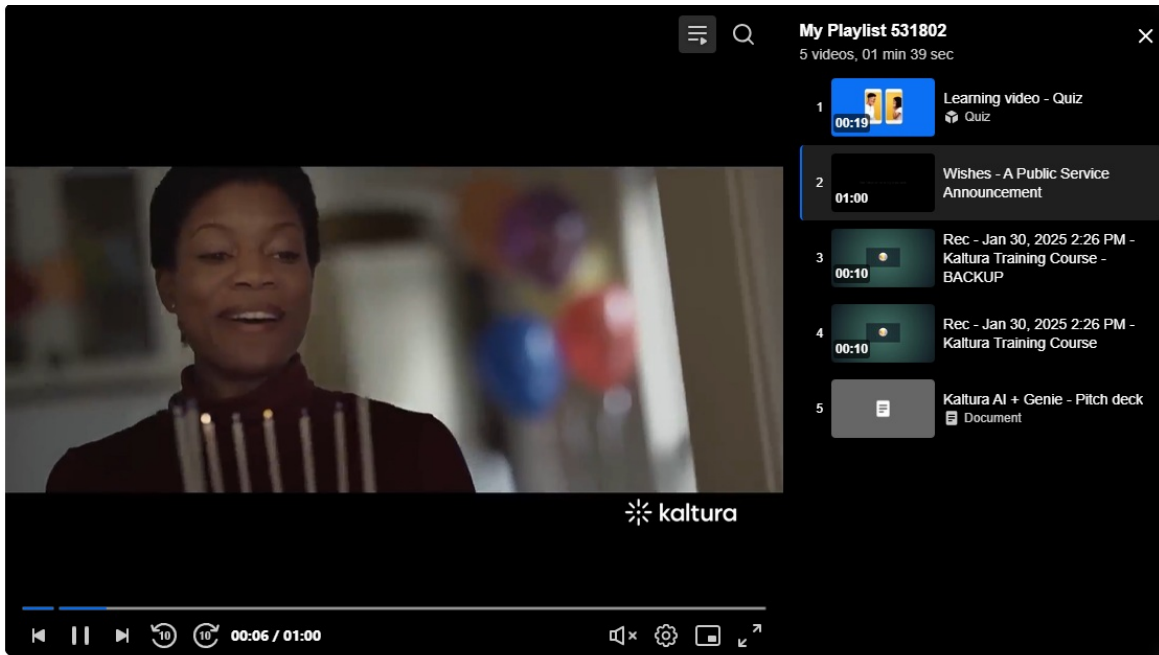
Access the downloads settings

2. Click the **three dots** under the player.

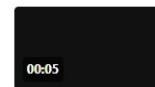

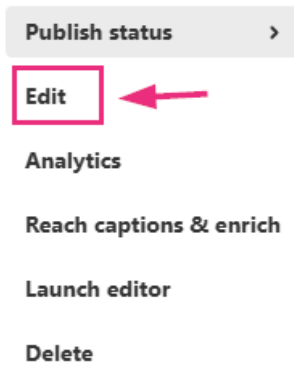

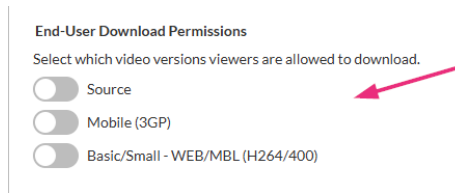
