2. Configure the following:

**enabled** - Set to 'Yes' to enable the module.

**allowedRoles** - Select the minimum role allowed to use the feature. Choose from the following options:

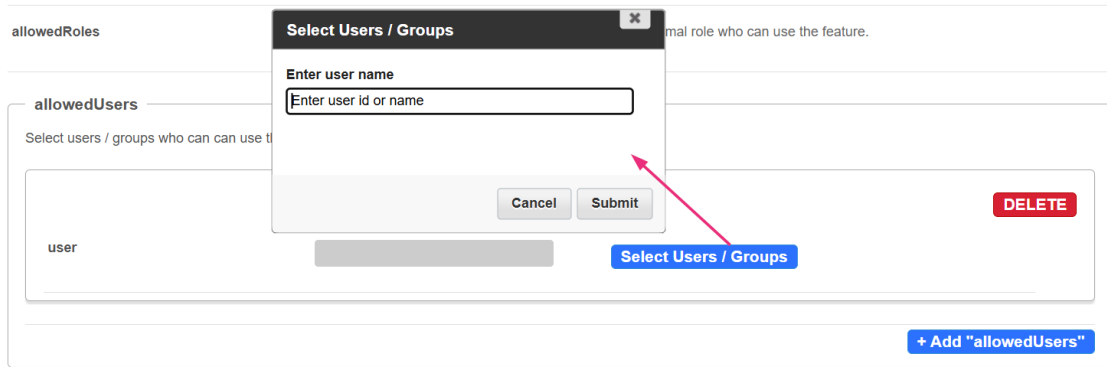
- privateonly Role
- admin Role
- unmoderatedadmin Role
- Specific users/groups

If you select **Specific users/groups**, the **allowedUsers** field displays.

**allowedRoles**  Select the minimal role who can use the feature.

**allowedUsers** Select users / groups who can use the feature

- Click **+Add "allowedUsers"**.
- In the **user** field that opens, click **Select Users / Groups**.



c. In the 'Select users/groups' popup, enter a user ID or name, then click **Submit**.

Repeat these steps to add additional users.

3. Click **Save**.
