## About

Comments allow users to participate in discussions directly on a media page.

If comments are enabled by your administrator, you can control whether comments are available for individual media items from the **Comments** tab on the edit page.

You can enable or disable comments for the following supported media items:

- Video
- Audio
- Image
- YouTube
- Document
- Draft entries



Comments for [Kaltura Rooms](#) are managed separately through the **Interactions** settings.

- Co-editors (depending on permissions)

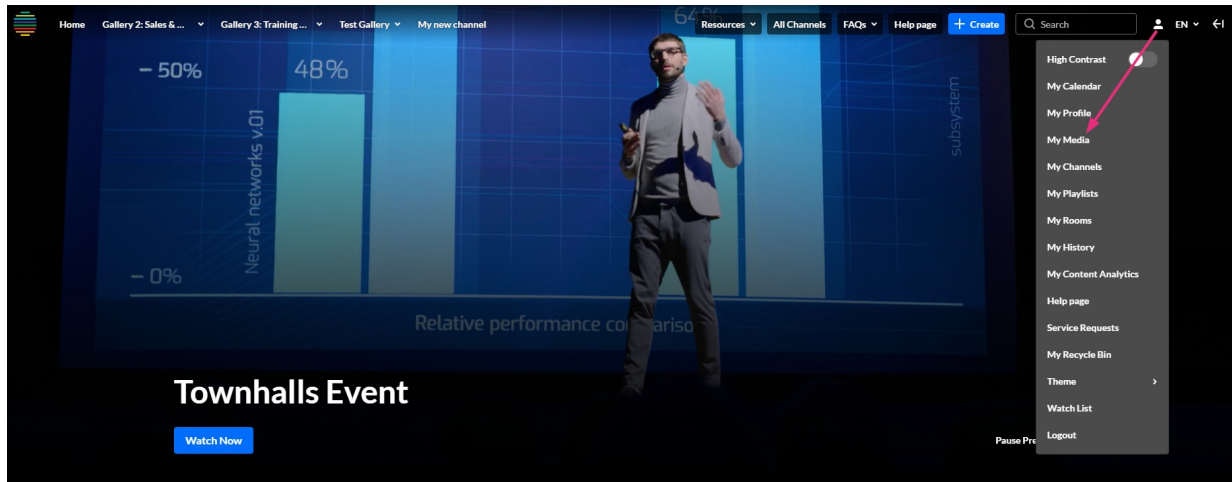
